
Hand Sanitisers to be provided at the entrance to all visitors when boarding the vessel



Aisles shall be a minimum of 2.5 metres width in areas of one way traffic and 4 metres for 2-way traffic



Clear signage of maximum capacity allowed at any one time to be displayed on the front of the stand or meeting room or all enclosed facilities.



Avoid shaking hands and exchanging business cards

Exhibitors must sanitise high touch points/ areas within their exhibition stand frequently



All product demos must observe a 2 metre social distance. The viewing area should with in the product display area and also needs to incorporate social distancing of 2 metres



All activations must observe a 2 metre social distance. The viewing area should within the dedicated activation area and also needs to incorporate social distancing of 2 metres



Health & Safety Wardens will strictly enforce all policies. A penalty of AED 3,000 may be levied by government authorities for non-compliance



All products, furniture and high touch points on the stand need to be sanitised after every use. Gloves to be readily available if required



Buffet permitted if served by waiting staff. Individually packaged food and beverage items also available.

Entertainment **NOT PERMITED** on the exhibitions stands or vessels



Food and beverages to be consumed in dedicated F&B areas where masks may be removed when seated.



Water dispensers are not permitted. Only bottled water allowed



All promotional materials must be downloaded digitally through QR codes



Prayer rooms are open and follow federal guidelines



Contactless transactions are encouraged



PCR Testing Clinic managed by Dubai Health Authority available onsite



Isolation rooms are set up at the venue for suspected cases and managed with Dubai Health Authority (DHA).

VACHTS, BOATS & LEISURE CRAFT



Sanitise the vessel completely before event opens daily



Vessel Capacity should not exceed 50% as per Dubai Maritime City Authority regulations



Vessels with capacity of (10) ten people and below are allowed to operate with full capacity if all of the people onboard are from the same family



Crew to ensure that all visitors are offered hand sanitisers prior to entering the vessel



Social distancing signage and floor stickers to be placed at entrance and onboard vessel



Masks, disposable shoe covers and gloves to be made available onboard for all crew and visitors



Vessels should be sanitised regularly throughout the day and hightouch points to be sanitised after each use.

Restrooms to be cleaned and sanitised after each use



PPE Waste Bins to be provided on each vessel by the exhibitors
