Tony Boulton of MERKUR UK and Ian Miller, Property Director for Luxury Leisure/Talarius, will provide updates and analysis of the contribution and challenges that face high street AGC operators including those presented by anti-gambling groups. Pragmatix Consultancy, who have reported on the High Street for the Local Government Association will open the slot with an analysis of the future of the high street and what the offer will look like


