<p><b>Delivery Address</b></p>	<p>Company Name, Stand Number, Hall 2 BETA International, 22nd - 23rd September 2024 c/o NAEC Stoneleigh Stoneleigh Park Warwickshire CV8 2LG</p>
<p><b>Deliveries &amp; Collections</b></p>	<p>Deliveries cannot be accepted outside of the show timetable dates.</p> <p>We strongly recommend you use the appointed contractors, Exhibit 3Sixty Logistics, for any deliveries during the build-up of the show. If you are using your own courier, make sure they can deliver on the build-up which is Friday 20th or Saturday 21st September. Deliveries outside of these dates will have to be completed by Exhibit 3Sixty Logistics as they will be able to accept your goods on your behalf and deliver them to your stand when required.</p> <p>Deliveries to exhibitions are unlike usual deliveries to a postal address and as such there can be problems with outside couriers finding stands - we have had cases where couriers have arrived at the venue and not even asked where to find the stand, or arrived without means to unload, and have simply taken the goods back to their warehouse.</p> <p>Please ensure you bring your own trolley on-site.</p> <p>For contact details of Exhibit 3Sixty Logistics please refer to the Official Contractors section.</p> <p>If you are intending to have any goods delivered to your stand by outside contractors, it is important that they are aware of the traffic systems in place at the venue and that you arrange for a representative of your company to be on the stand to receive the goods. BETA International cannot accept responsibility for any goods delivered to an unmanned stand.</p> <p>Companies using couriers to deliver their goods to their stands must inform the handling agent that they must provide their own trolleys and porters. These are not available at the venue. Only the official lifting and forwarding contractors, Exhibit 3Sixty Logistics, will be permitted to operate forklifts on-site at BETA International. Lifting must be booked directly with Exhibit 3Sixty.</p> <p>If you are arranging for goods to be collected after the show closes, please do not leave them unattended on your stand at any time before they are collected.</p> <p>BETA International cannot accept responsibility for damage or loss to any stands or goods in transit to and from the show.</p> <p>All products and standfitting must be removed by 22.30hrs on Monday 23rd September. Nothing can be left in the hall after this time. Any items not removed by this time will be disposed of, and costs for disposal charged directly to the exhibitor concerned.</p>
<p><b>Travelling By Road</b></p>	<p>From London / M40:- Leave the M40 at junction 15 and head on the A46 towards Coventry. Follow the signs to Stoneleigh Park Main Entrance or NAEC on the B4113.</p> <p>From the M6 / M69:- Leave the M6 at junction 2 and head onto the A46 towards Warwick. Or at the end of the M69, head onto the A46 towards Warwick and the M40. Follow the signs to Stoneleigh Park Main Entrance or NAEC on the B4113</p>

	<p>From the M1 (Northbound):- Leave the M1 at Junction 17 and join the M45 heading towards Coventry. Pick up the signs for the A45 Coventry (NOT Daventry). Stay on the A45 heading towards the A46 Warwick. Once on the A46, follow the signs to Stoneleigh Park Main Entrance or NAEC on the B4113.</p> <p>On arrival at the NAEC Stoneleigh all vehicles will be directed to the rear of the Halls. Vehicles can unload/deliver to their stands from the vehicle doors at the rear of the Halls. This will be on a first-come, first-served basis. They will then need to move their vehicles to spaces available in the main car park situated at the front of the venue and the outer car parks.</p>
<b>Travelling By Rail</b>	<p>Coventry Station (5.2 miles) 10 Station Square, Coventry, CV1 2GT. Tel:- 0800 0158123</p> <p>Coventry station is a regular stop for the Virgin West Coast Mainline and Cross Country Trains. There are frequent services from Birmingham New Street and Birmingham International and services from London Euston every 30 minutes on weekdays.</p> <p>Leamington Spa Station (5.5 miles) ld Warwick Road, Leamington Spa, Warwickshire, CV31 3NS. Tel:-0345 600 5165</p> <p>Warwick Parkway Station (7.7 miles) Old Budbrooke Road, near Warwick, Warwickshire, CV35 8RH. Tel:- 0345 600 5165</p> <p>Leamington Spa and Warwick Parkway stations are both regular stops for Chiltern Railways. There are frequent services from Birmingham Moor Street and Birmingham Snow Hill and services from London Marylebone every 30 minutes on weekdays.</p> <p>From all of the above mainline stations you will need to take a short taxi ride to the Venue. <b>Travelling By Air</b>	<p>Birmingham International Airport (15.2 miles) Birmingham, B26 3QJ, telephone 0871 222 0072</p> <p>There is a regular rail service from Birmingham International Rail Station to Coventry Rail Station and then NAEC Stoneleigh is a 5 mile taxi journey from there. <b>Car Parking</b>	<p>Car parking is free of charge for exhibitors &amp; visitors at BETA International 2024. Marked disabled parking bays are available near the main entrance.</p>
<b>Vehicle Passes</b>	<p>If you are making any deliveries to BETA International at NAEC Stoneleigh you will require a vehicle ID ticket. This will show the name of the exhibition, your company name and stand number, and must be displayed in the windscreen of each vehicle. A copy of this vehicle ID ticket is available to print off from the Ezone menu.</p>
