Our courses suit all experience levels and 4WD makes and models and are held in various locations around the state. We also specialize in chainsaw training to keep you and your family safe on the tracks.

4WD Operation and Recovery - Accredited Training

This course covers three nationally accredited units, teaching you real world skills to make sure you can conquer anything in front of you on your trips.

Course timeframe → 2 days plus pre learning
Units Include:

- ✓ FWPCOT3325 - Operate a 4WD on Unsealed Roads
- ✓ FWPCOT3326 - Recover a 4WD Vehicle
- ✓ FWPCOT3329 - Perform Complex 4x4 Operations

Chainsaw Training - Accredited Training

This course is designed to teach you basic cuts on fallen timber and maintenance on your saw. All you should need to cut down trees blocking tracks on your trips to get you home safe.

Course timeframe → 2 days plus pre learning
Units Include:

- ✓ FWPCOT2254 - Maintain Chainsaws
- ✓ FWPCOT2273 - Trim and Cut Felled Trees

Proficiency 4WD Training - Non Accredited Training

This course is our most popular course. It is a good entry level course for beginner 4WDers but also able to be scaled to suit 4WDers of any skill level. No matter what previous experiences you have had, you are sure to learn something new here. Topics covered include:

- ✓ Water crossings
- ✓ Pre and post trip vehicle inspections
- ✓ Safe ascent and descent techniques for a variety of hill steepness
- ✓ How to navigate side angles
- ✓ Kinetic recoveries – how to undertake these safely
- ✓ Driving in a large variety of conditions
- ✓ Bog holes – how to navigate
- ✓ Vehicle technologies and high and low range and when to engage it

Course timeframe → 1 day plus pre learning
