The APPMA Awards of Excellence will be presented at the Gala Awards Ceremony dinner on Wednesday 18th May, 2022 at the Melbourne Exhibition and Convention Centre as part of AUSPACK 2022

Award Assessment Criteria AUSTRALIAN MACHINERY MANUFACTURING AWARD

Recognising Australian-based manufacturing, innovation and success of a product launched into the domestic and/or export market in the past three years.

There will be two awards for this category:

- SME award for companies with less than \$10 million in annual turnover
- Corporate Award for companies with over \$10 million in annual turnover

Eligibility:

Equipment must be designed and manufactured in Australia. Submissions can include complete standalone machines or add on machinery. Open to Members (both exhibiting and non-exhibiting), Open to Non-member Australian based Manufacturing exhibitors.

Criteria:

Background and Description 10%

Tell us about the product/solution. How did it come about? Why did it come about? Provide a full description of the product/solution including process, program, deliverables, installation, and equipment alliances.

Other Benefits 25%

What other benefits such as reduction of environmental impact, reduction of food wastage, energy efficiency has the product achieved? List any other benefits of the product.

Unique Features / Innovation 25%

What were the design features or innovations and how did they improve end-user ROI, cost of ownership, productivity and efficiency?

Award Assessment Criteria IMPORT & DISTRIBUTION MACHINERY AWARD

Recognising innovation and success in equipment launched in Australia in the past three years.

There will be two awards for this category:

- SME award for companies with less than \$10 million in annual turnover
- Corporate Award for companies with over \$10 million in annual turnover

Eligibility:

Equipment must be principally designed by an overseas supplier who is represented by an Australian based company or registered Australian Office for an International principal.

This can be a new standalone machine or a significant add/innovative piece of machinery.

Open to Members (both exhibiting and non-exhibiting),

Open to Non-member Australian based Manufacturing exhibitors.

Criteria:

Background and Description 10%

Tell us about the product/solution. How did it come about? Why did it come about? Provide a full description of the product/solution including process, program, deliverables, installation, and equipment alliances.

Other Benefits 25%

What other benefits such as reduction of environmental impact, reduction of food wastage, energy efficiency has the product achieved? List any other benefits of the product.

Unique Features / Innovation 25%

What were the design features or innovations and how did they improve end-user ROI, cost of ownership, productivity and efficiency?



Award Assessment Criteria PACKAGING DESIGN INNOVATION AWARD

Recognises design innovation and success as a result of a new idea or modification introduced into a packaging design.

Eligibility:

The nominated project must have been completed within the 24 month period preceding March 2022, proposals or partly implemented projects are not eligible.

Open to Members (Exhibiting and non-exhibiting),

Open to Non-member Australian based exhibitors.

Applicable to large and small companies as well as collaboration projects.

Note - Packaging Materials are not eligible in this category but would be eligible under the sustainability category.

Criteria:

Background and Description 10%

Tell us about the product/solution. How did it come about? Why did it come about? Provide a full description of the product/solution including process, program, deliverables, installation, and equipment alliances.

Other Benefits 25%

What other benefits such as reduction of environmental impact, reduction of food wastage, energy efficiency has the product achieved? List any other benefits of the product.

Unique Features / Innovation 25%

What were the design features or innovations and how did they improve end-user ROI, cost of ownership, productivity and efficiency?



Award Assessment Criteria SUSTAINABILITY AWARD

Focused on environmental sustainability, such as recycling, food waste redistribution, environmentally friendly energy supply and so on.

This category incorporates sustainability projects recognising organisations showing leadership and commitment to environmentally sustainable business practices, through innovative solutions for new and existing market needs.

Eligibility:

The nominated project must have been completed within the 24 month period preceding March 2022, proposals or partly implemented projects are not eligible.

Submissions can include collaborative projects between members and customers,

or members and Fight Food Waste CRC.

The nominated project must have been completed within the 24 month period preceding March 2022, proposals or partly implemented projects are not eligible.

Open to Members (Exhibiting and non-exhibiting),

Open to Non-member Australian based exhibitors.

Criteria:

Background and Description 10%

Tell us about the product/solution. How did it come about? Why did it come about? Provide a full description of the product/solution including process, program, deliverables, installation, and equipment alliances.

Other Benefits 25%

What other benefits such as reduction of environmental impact, reduction of food wastage, energy efficiency has the product achieved? List any other benefits of the product. Weighting 25%.

Unique Features / Innovation 25%

Award Assessment Criteria COMMUNITY CONTRIBUTION AWARD

Recognising organisations that demonstrate leadership and commitment community wellbeing. The APPMA supports Foodbank, OZHARVEST and the FFWCRC because each makes a difference to individual communities and society.

This award recognises members' industry-level contributions during the past two to three years. The community benefits could be via projects, initiatives or causes related to support across education, fire relief, COVID-19, food distribution, sport sponsorship, charity involvement and so forth.

Eligibility:

The APPMA encourage involvement in projects, initiatives and causes that deliver social/community benefit during the past 2-3 years (incl. COVID).

Open to all APPMA Members only (Exhibiting and non- exhibiting. Full and Associate Members).

Criteria:

Background and Description 25%

Tell us about the product/program including the number of people involved; how long has it been running; why did you implement this initiative and is your contribution paid or voluntary?

Supporting Information and Community Acknowledgement 20%


Provide community testimonials demonstrating how the initiative has delivered support and benefit to the community. You can use media clippings, testimonials and photos as well as commentaory to respond to this question.

Unique Features / Innovation 25%

Outline both the short and long-term goals of the initiative. Describe the barriers or difficulties and how they have been overcome.

Impact 30%

How has the relevant community benefited from this initiative?





Award Assessment Criteria EMERGING LEADERSHIP AWARD

Recognising individuals demonstrating capability, expertise and leadership qualities within the Packaging and Processing industry whether that be in research, development and innovation, technical design and implementation, product evaluation or overall business operations. Winners are provided with an opportunity to play an ambassadorial role within the industry.

Eligibility:

Individuals under the age of 35 with five plus year's employment/business ownership within the Packaging and Processing Industry. Submissions to include a desired educational plan.

Open to APPMA Member Employees only (Exhibiting and non- exhibiting),

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Criteria:

Career Background & Overview 15%

Provide an overview of the nominee's career history to date in the P&P Industry including roles, companies milestones, role development, areas of expertise. In addition provide information on any industry and/or peer recognition received; academic achievements / qualifications, scholarships, honours; attributes and qualities that make the nominee an emerging leader.

Supporting Information & Industry Testimonials 15%


What other benefits such as reduction of environmental impact, reduction of food wastage, energy efficiency has the product achieved? List any other benefits of the product.

Recognition, Influence and Success 30%

What were the design features or innovations and how did they improve end-user ROI, cost of ownership, productivity and efficiency? .

Future Aspirations and Plans 30%

Outline your short and longer-term career and personal goals. Identify a business/career challenge to date, how your managed and the key learnings. Outline the qualities that you consider important in future leaders. Detail the factors that you consider had the most influence on your progress and success to date and why you consider them so. Attach a document outlining your 2-5 year training and educational/ development roadmap including preferred courses and fee estimates if applicable. (max 2 pages)





Frequently Asked Questions

Who can enter?

Entries into the APPMA Awards of Excellence are open to any APPMA member (as at 01 July 2021) or AUSPACK 2022 exhibitor who has a product or solution that meets the eligibility criteria specified in the award assessment criteria.

Can I enter more than one category?

Yes a company may lodge submissions in multiple categories on condition the separate submissions do not reference/ include the same machinery/ equipment. Each category has different criteria and requires a separate entry, however you can enter as many categories as you wish.

How long will it take to prepare an entry?

Entries for the APPMA Awards of Excellence are designed to be as accessible as possible to all members of the industry. The entry process is web based and completed on a simple form which addresses the criteria and restricts answers to the word limits supplied. There is also the option to save and edit your application before final submission. Completing your entry form should not be a long or difficult process.

Who judges the APPMA Awards of Excellence?

A panel of Australian and international industry peers and media who have been invited by the APPMA Board on a voluntary basis.

What is the judging process?

Assessment is a two-stage process and the applications for each category will be reviewed by at least three members of the judging panel. The published award category criteria are the basis for scoring. Each criteria is weighted to allow applicants to focus their efforts appropriately when writing their submission. There is also a word limit for responses.

The judges will review each application independently and submit an initial score according to the published criteria. This will result in an initial shortlist of all entries to identify Category Finalists. – who are announced in late February. If required, finalist entries in each category will proceed to a second round of assessment by the judging panel to determine the winners.

Judge's scores and comments will be collated to determine the finalists

and to generate a personalised Feedback & Benchmarking Report – so all entries receive insight on areas of improvement. The Judges decision is final.

What will happen if the judges have a question about my entry?

Upon submission of your entry you will be asked to supply the details of a contact person who can answer any questions the judging panel may have regarding your entry.

Do I receive a ticket to the APPMA Awards of Excellence Gala Dinner if I become a finalist?

No, tickets must be purchased to attend the Gala Dinner on 18th May at Melbourne Convention & Exhibition Centre.

Can sponsors of the APPMA Awards of Excellence enter?

Sponsors can enter the APPMA Awards of Excellence and the judging process and criteria will ensure that any conflict of interest issues are dealt with.





Terms & Conditions of Entry

- Where a project or solution has been carried out in collaboration with or on behalf of a client, letters of support are to be included with your submission.
- Each category has individual eligibility requirements as well as judging criteria. Entrants are strongly urged to thoroughly familiarise themselves with these requirements and criteria before commencing their submission
- All winning joint entries are only eligible for a single trophy. A duplicate trophy may be purchased post event.
- Each entry will be scored by three judges for each award. Each criteria will be marked by a judge and given a score. Not all criteria will be weighted equally. A maximum score of 100 is possible from each

judge giving 300 in total. The entry with the highest score will be deemed the winner.

- By entering you give APPMA and its appointed contractor/representative permission to publish information contained within your submission including photography, company logo, profiles and non-pecuniary information. You also grant permission to pass your contact details to media for publicity purposes.
- APPMA reserves the right not to proceed with an award category. Should the decision be made to not make an award in a category, APPMA reserves the right to reallocate an entry to another category.
- The judges decision is final and there will be no appeals.

How to Enter

Who can enter?

All entries must be submitted via the official APPMA Awards of Excellence online portal at auspack. com.au/awards no later than 4th March 2022

The APPMA Awards of Excellence program is free to enter, however you will need to register your details and create an 'account' before commencing your submission.

How to enter the APPMA Awards of Excellence 2022

- 1. Go to www.auspack.com.au/ awards
- Register for an account. This should include the contact information for the person within your organisation who is the best person to contact or ask questions about your submission
- 3. Commence your submission online
- 4. The program allows you to save edits as you go, so you do not have to complete the submission in one session
- Check you have met all criteria and uploaded relevant attachments and supporting documentation
- If you are entering more than one category you will need to submit a separate entry for each submission
- 7. Submit your entry before the closing date
