By integrating IMS with barcode scanners, mobile computers, wireless LANs, and radio frequency identification (RFID) technology, IMS provides accurate real-time tracking of products' movement and storage. Standard functionality includes inventory collection and storage processes, manual and automated picking, and tracking items to be shipped. IMS records and tracks every stock item received, picked, packed, and shipped.


