# ENSURE A FAVORABLE INDUSTRY OPERATING ENVIRONMENT

- Bring back communicable disease coverage to event cancellation insurance \*
- Increase <u>music licensing</u> transparency and stop anti-competitive behavior by music rights holders \*

  BMI v. North American Concert Promoters Association appeal
- Strengthen support for <u>industry small businesses</u>, including SBA reauthorization and modernization
- Finalize new FTC rule prohibiting business impersonation fraud and increasing enforcement capability
- Establish a pro-growth/innovation federal privacy statute that harmonizes existing state privacy laws





# **GROW SEAMLESS INTERNATIONAL TRAVEL & COMMERCE**

- Restore visa operations to pre-pandemic levels while modernizing the <u>visa processing</u> system \*
  - S.2632: Visa Processina Improvement Act
  - H.R.4665: Department of State, Foreign Operations, and Related Programs Appropriations Act
  - H.R.5127: Visitor Wait Time Reduction Act
- Help prevent future <u>international travel restrictions</u>
- Streamline and harmonize travel policies between the U.S. and key international partners and regions
- Strengthen public-sector programs that <u>attract international events</u> to the U.S. (and retain them) and <u>recruit international attendees</u> to U.S. events
- Ensure favorable global standardization efforts

# CREATE A WELCOMING ENVIRONMENT FOR THE INDUSTRY

- Prevent anti-growth <u>state and local taxation</u> of our industry
- Block state and local efforts to restrict the continuity and <u>freedom of operations</u> of business events
- Oppose event boycotts and policy-driven operational restrictions





#### CHAMPION INDUSTRY-LED DECARBONIZATION EFFORTS

- Promote industry-led <u>sustainability and decarbonization</u> efforts that ensure the industry remains in control of its path to Net Zero \*
  - California Zero-Emission Forklift Regulation
- Encourage <u>smart decarbonization</u> initiatives by government entities while ensuring the right balance between environmental aims and industry feasibility

### **DEVELOP THE INDUSTRY'S FUTURE WORKFORCE**

- Support government policies to help attract and train the industry's next generation workforce \*
  - S.161/H.R.793: Jumpstarting Our Businesses by Supporting Students (JOBS) Ac
  - o S.722/H.R.1477: Freedom to Invest in Tomorrow's Workforce Act
  - H.R.6585: Bipartisan Workforce Pell Ac-
  - H.R.6655: A Stronger Workforce for America Ac
- Amplify efforts to raise awareness of the business events industry to our <u>future talent pool</u> (high school and college programs, internships, school counselor outreach, trade school programs, etc.) \*
- Support industry-wide efforts to secure a U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics NAICS code for the industry
