Wander among Arctic Foxes, Walruses and Whales on this 6-night nature photo holiday to Svalbard

Lying halfway between Norway and the North Pole, Svalbard is a wild land of glaciers and tundra, making it an irresistible destination for the artist or traveller inspired by nature. Unlike larger commercial tours, we will base ourselves for 5 full days in one location, the charming town of Longyearbyen, to make the most of its unique landscapes and help you take stunning images of walruses, whales, seabirds and resident foxes. Activities are tailored to whatever animals are active at the time of day, as well as to weather/light conditions. Each day, we will discuss options on how best to maximise your creative and wildlife viewing opportunities.

- Stay in a traditional cabin (single-supplement), with friendly huskies and Common Eiders as our neighbours
- Boat-trips and landings to a Walrus colony, with chance of Beluga, Blue Whale, Bearded Seal and Polar Bear
- Repeat close encounters with Arctic Foxes that hunt around town and in the neighbouring valley
- Water-level photography of Red-Throated Diver, King Eider, Phalarope and Long-Tailed Duck courtships
- Visits to nesting seabird cliff colonies of Little Auk, Brunnich's Guillemot and Blue Fulmar
- Experience Arctic culture, cuisine and tradition in a historic coalmining town





### PELICANS OF KERKINI

Photograph the charismatic Dalmatian Pelican in Greece this winter

During this workshop, we will focus on photographing the charismatic Dalmatian Pelicans that spend the winter on Lake Kerkini. Over 5 days, you'll be able to build a stunning and varied portfolio, with the help of experienced photo guides and local fishermen who have developed an intimate relationship with the birds over many years. Exclusive daily boat trips and shoreline feed sessions – at sunrise and sunset, in mist and snow – offer unparalleled opportunities for close-up portrait, flight, and behavioural shots of these rare birds. Winter is prime time to visit Lake Kerkini, with over 100 Pelicans on the lake. So free up those memory cards – you'll need the space!

- 5 private boat trips and shoreline feeds with Dalmatian and Great White Pelicans
- Photo opportunities with other local wildlife including Golden Jackals, Wild Cats and Greater Spotted Eagles
- Visit to a major wetland near Thessaloniki for Flamingos, Pygmy Cormorants, Kingfishers, and much more
- Local guides with intimate knowledge of the area, and excellent guide-to-client ratio with 1-on-1 tuition
- Single supplement en-suite rooms in a comfortable guesthouse by the lake

With rolling hills, medieval villages, crystal-clear rivers and lush beech woodlands, the Abruzzo National Park in central Italy offers you the chance to observe the country's most iconic animals in spectacular surroundings. June is prime time for seeing the rare Marsican Brown Bears as they come to the town's cherry orchards to feed. The abundance of summer bird migrants and an alluring variety of butterflies will appeal to all naturalists. Combined with traditional cuisine and culture, this wildlife holiday offers a well-rounded Italian experience.

- High chance of endangered Marsican Bear and Apennine Wolf during dawn and dusk watches
- Photograph Chamois at sunset in the montane wildflower meadows
- Rutting red deer along the crystal Sangro River
- Visits to beech forests and mountains for birds such as Hoopoe, Rock Partridge and Lilford's Woodpecker
- Butterfly photography with up to 30 species thriving in the meadows around town
- Expert Italian/English speaking guides with up-to-date knowledge on where to spot our main targets

## RAPTORS OF THE PYRENEES

Photograph eagles, hawks, vultures and owls in the wild heart of Catalonia this winter

The cry of an eagle and the whoosh of wings as it lands feet away from you! This new photography workshop targets the spectacular raptors that can be found in the mountains and plains of Catalonia – from the regal Bearded Vulture which scavenges on bones, to precision hunters such as the Goshawk and Bonelli's Eagle. Immersing ourselves in the wild heart of southern Spain, our hide sessions will take advantage of every minute of light to capture feeding, fighting and courtship behaviours. Some hides allow remote wide-angle setups, offering a uniquely intimate perspective into the spectacular events of these birds' lives.

- 5 nights' single supplement stay in an enchanting medieval fortress town in the Pyrenees
- Photograph up to 8 raptor, 3 vulture and 3 owl species in mountain, steppe, lake and farmland habitat
- Learn skills for capturing dynamic photos of birds in flight, feeding, hunting, bathing and fighting
- Remote wide-angle photography with eagles and owls in their environment (guidance can be provided)
- Private access to multiple photography hides at ground and water level
- Expert guidance and 1-on-1 tuition in photography techniques, wide-angle setups, and editing





### WILD MADRID

A private sanctuary for Spain's rarest birdlife – just a stone's throw from Spain's capital

For this workshop, we have exclusive access to a private 8000-hectare estate on the outskirts of Madrid, with a network of ground and water-level hides dedicated to photographing some of Spain's rarest creatures such as Spanish Imperial Eagle and Genet. The combination of private access (we are the only company outside of Spain that has been granted access), rare ancient holm oak woodland, a higher density of Spanish Imperial Eagles than found anywhere else in Spain, and proximity to Madrid, make this a truly unique photo destination.

- 4 nights' single supplement stay in a charming medieval town near Madrid
- Exclusive access and permits to the estate and its extensive network of ground and water-level hides
- Photograph the Spanish Imperial Eagle, Spain's rarest and most iconic bird of prey
- Over 20 bird photo hides for Azure-Winged Magpie, Goshawk, Crested Tit, Iberian Shrike, Little Owl and more
- Expert guiding and 1-on-1 tuition from award-winning photographer and local guides
- Photography excursions for lbex and nesting White Storks in the nearby mountains
- Optional night photography for Genets using artificial lighting setup





## SEALS OF NORFOLK

A full photographic immersion at the UK's largest Grey Seal colony

For this winter workshop, we'll stay in a beachfront cottage with access to the UK's largest Grey Seal colony, during the height of the pupping season! Shooting from dawn to dusk under my guidance, you'll learn how to capture stunning images of seals in a variety of wintry conditions, among the sand-dunes and crashing waves. We should observe seals giving birth, tender interactions between mothers and pups, and battles between bull seals for dominance. With so much going on around us, we will spend time exploring many creative options with our cameras, from experimenting with shutterspeed and backlight, to high-key black and white images. Like mu "Pelicans of Kerkini" workshop, this trip targets one species to push your photography to the next level.

# MACRO PHOTOGRAPHY

Master close-up photography with bountiful butterflies, moths and orchids on Winchester's chalk downlands

Macro photography provides a fascinating insight into the world of insects and flowers. This full-day workshop will focus on a few chalkhill and meadow sites around Winchester for a colourful variety of lepidoptera species and orchids too. Butterflies will be our main target, with many species on the wing such as the Chalkhill Blue, Common Blue and rarer Adonis, the Brown Argus, Essex Skipper, Brimstone, and Peacock, and day-flying moths such as Six-Spot Burnet and Cinnabar. We'll make the most of the summer sun, playing with lighting conditions, colour and texture to create compelling portraits of our miniature subjects. We may also explore the nearby RIver Itchen for Golden-Ringed Dragonfly and Pyramidal Orchid.

- Learn the art of macro through composition, exposure and depth of field
- Push your creative possibilities with colour harmony and contrast, texture and Ivariations of light
- Learn advanced camera techniques such as double exposure, high key imagery and focus stacking

### SCOTTISH SHORES

Photograph the spectacle of 20,000 Pink-Footed Geese and more this winter off the east coast of Scotland

We will spend the first part of the day at North Berwick beach, photographing a variety of shorebirds feeding along the shoreline, against the dramatic backgrop of Bass Rock. At this time of year, the morning light often gives rich golden hues, allowing opportunities to capture striking bird portraits and behaviours with a range of approachable bird species such as Purple Sandpiper, Sanderling, Black-Tailed Godwit. Ringed PLover, and Redshank. We will then head to Aberlady Bay, a protected reserve where we will look for Short-Eared Owls hunting over the sand dunes and winter thrushes feasting on sea buckthorn. At sunset, we will be in position for the spectacular dusk flight of 20,000 Pink-Footed Geese returning to roost over the Firth of Forth.

## WINTER WETLANDS

Dancing cranes and majestic waterfowl are among the winter highlights at WWT Slimbridge reserve









Gloucestershire, UK

The aim of this beginner class is to help you capture beautiful portraits and behavioural photos of birds found on the reserve and in its exotic collections. Every winter, the wetlands are deliberately flooded, meaning that we can expect to see up to 50,000 waterfowl – among them White–Fronted Geese, Golden Plover, Pintail, Wigeon and Lapwing. Occasionally raptors such as Peregrine, or Goshawk may hunt for sitting ducks, resulting in spectacular chases. This is also one of the best places in the country to see Common Cranes, and we will try to photograph their elegant courtship dance. Before sunset, we'll be in position at the lakeside to photograph the mesmerisingsight of hundreds of Bewick's Swans flying into roost.

### URBAN WILDLIFE

Photograph parakeets, grey herons and other iconic urban wildlife in the heart of London

During this 3 hour class in London. you'll have the opportunity to photograph many species of bird at close range in a fun and creative setting. The day will begin with a brief introduction on wildlife and flora we should find and tips on photographing birds in pose and flight. We will then head into Regents Park to photograph iconic city species such as friendly Grey Herons, courting Great-Crested Grebes, elegant Mandarin ducks, tree-dwelling Egyptian Geese and goslings, and Ring-Necked Parakeet flocks. Bird activity is highest in the morning when the lakes are often shrouded in wonderful mists, allowing possibilities for beautiful images. We may even see Tawny or Little Owls which roost in the park's oak trees, or a Kingfisher along the Serpentine.
