





HEALTH & FITNESS LEVEL REQUIREMENTS

This tour is suitable for guests with a moderate level of fitness and good general health.

While most wildlife viewing is done from comfortable safari boats, participants should be able to manage short walks, climb in and out of boats with ease, and tolerate warm, humid conditions typical of the Pantanal.

The itinerary is relaxed but immersive, with early starts and long days on the water, so stamina and enthusiasm for outdoor activity are important.

If you have any specific health concerns, we recommend consulting your doctor before travel to ensure you're well-prepared for the adventure.



RECOMMENDED EQUIPMENT

We recommend the following equipment. If you'd like to discuss your specific gear, just reach out, and we'll be happy to advise.

- Camera that can photograph in manual mode and RAW files (mirrorless or DSLR)
- A range of lenses, ideally including a telephoto lens
- Spare battery and memory card
- Laptop with editing software (Lightroom Classic)
- Enough storage space for your images
- Tripod
- Sturdy camera bag
- Rain cover for camera (when you're photographing the Victoria Falls in wet season)
