


GREENLAND PHOTO TOUR

Greenland, the world's largest island, is a land of extremes—where ice, water, and light create a photographer's paradise. From snow-capped landscapes to dramatic fjords and glaciers, Greenland offers some of the planet's most breathtaking views.

Our tour is based in Disko Bay on the western coast, above the Arctic Circle, surrounded by icebergs, deep-blue waters, and abundant wildlife. As we venture north, we'll encounter humpback whales, seals, and other marine life in the serene Icefjord, offering unique photographic opportunities, especially with the calm waters reflecting the stunning scenery.

This photography tour is designed for all levels of experience, whether you're a seasoned pro or an enthusiastic beginner. With expert guidance from award-winning photographers, you'll capture some of the world's most awe-inspiring natural wonders.



HIGHLIGHTS


Greenland's Disko Bay is a dreamscape of Arctic beauty, where massive icebergs drift through deep-blue waters under the golden glow of the midnight sun.

Based in Ilulissat, guests explore the UNESCO-listed Icefjord aboard a private boat, capturing surreal reflections, dramatic ice formations, and sweeping panoramas in extended golden-hour light. The low-angle sun creates rich textures and soft shadows, offering photographers rare opportunities to shoot for hours in magical conditions. With expert guidance from award-winning photographers, participants refine their skills while immersed in one of the world's most visually striking environments.

Wildlife encounters add another layer of excitement to the tour. Humpback whales, seals, and seabirds often appear amid the icebergs, offering dynamic subjects against breathtaking backdrops. The silence of the Arctic, broken only by the crack of calving ice or the breath of a surfacing whale, creates an atmosphere of awe and intimacy.

Every moment is tailored for photographers from the timing of excursions to the positioning of the boat - ensuring optimal conditions for capturing Greenland's raw, elemental beauty.


MEALS

HEALTH & FITNESS LEVEL REQUIRED

This tour is designed to be accessible to most travelers with a moderate level of fitness. While there are no strenuous hikes or physically demanding activities, participants should be comfortable walking short distances on uneven terrain, boarding and disembarking small boats, and standing for extended periods during photography sessions.

The Arctic environment can be brisk and occasionally unpredictable, so a basic level of mobility and stamina is important for comfort and safety. As long as you're steady on your feet and prepared for cool conditions, you'll be well-equipped to enjoy the experience.

RECOMMENDED EQUIPMENT

We recommend the following equipment. If you'd like to discuss your specific gear, just reach out, and we'll be happy to advise.

Recommended Camera Gear:

- Wide-angle and telephoto lenses
- Tripod for long exposures
- Extra batteries (cold temperatures reduce battery life)
- Polarizing and ND filters

Essential Travel Gear:

- Warm, waterproof clothing (Arctic conditions)
- Insulated gloves and waterproof boots
- Sunglasses for bright reflections off ice
