


SCOTLAND WILDLIFE PHOTOGRAPHY TOUR

THE DESTINATION

Wildlife Photography

As we explore the Scottish Highlands, you'll have the chance to photograph some of the UK's most iconic wildlife. One of the most spectacular events to capture is the Red Deer rut, where stags engage in dramatic displays of dominance. Other highlights include Red Squirrels, Crested Tits, and Mountain Hares, with a chance to spot the elusive Ptarmigan in the higher Cairngorms.

Landscape and Astrophotography

Along with wildlife, Scotland's landscapes provide awe-inspiring vistas for photography. You'll also have the chance to capture the night sky during optional astrophotography sessions. With its dark skies, Scotland offers the perfect setting for photographing stars and the Milky Way.






Conservation and Fieldcraft

In addition to photography, the workshop will cover fieldcraft and conservation. You'll learn how to track animal signs, understand wildlife behavior, and delve into the science behind the conservation efforts that protect these extraordinary species.

Guided by wildlife photographer Will Hall, you'll refine your skills and make the most of this experience. While the focus is primarily on wildlife photography, there will also be ample opportunities to practice and enhance your landscape and astrophotography techniques. This workshop is suitable for photographers of all levels, with Scotland's dramatic landscapes offering an abundance of photographic opportunities. From misty glens to towering mountains, the scenery is both majestic and serene, providing the perfect backdrop for wildlife photography.

- Conservation Focus: Learn about wildlife conservation and biology while enhancing your photography skills in the field.




YOUR PHOTOGRAPHY GUIDE:

ITINERARY

DAY 1: ARRIVAL

Arrival at accommodation, settle in, and welcome briefing for the week. Please Note: The daily schedule is flexible and may be adjusted based on weather conditions and wildlife movements.

DAY 2: BIRD PHOTOGRAPHY

Morning & afternoon photography with crested tits and woodland birds.

DAY 3: RED DEER

Morning & afternoon photography sessions with red deer, followed by an optional astrophotography session.

DAY 4: MOUNTAIN HARES & PHOTOGRAPHY HIDE

Morning photography with mountain hares, followed by an exclusive hide session in the afternoon/evening.

DAY 5: RED SQUIRRELS

Morning session with red squirrels and an afternoon optional session to revisit a particular species.

DAY 6: PTARMIGAN

Optional return to a location for specific species or an attempt to photograph ptarmigan. Evening image review session and group meal.

DAY 7: FINAL SESSION & DEPARTURE

Final morning photography session, followed by breakfast and departure.



ACCOMMODATION, MEALS & FACILITIES

- Range of lenses; ideally ranging from wide angle for landscape to telephoto for wildlife
- Tripod (useful)
- · Sturdy camera bag
- Enough spare batteries and memory cards (you'll be able to charge your batteries at our accommodation)
- Hard drive and a laptop / external drive
- Laptop with editing software

Essential Travel Gear:

- Comfortable and warm clothing (layers recommended)
- Waterproof jacket
- Sturdy walking shoes/boots
- Binoculars (not essential)
- Power adapters if you need them
