9 companies currently operate the Congo-Brazzaville oil fields













## **Congo mining domain**








### **MASTER PLAN GAS**

Establishment of a urea production industry due to its ability to support local agriculture with fertilizer.


Supply the ZES with natural gas for industrial needs (cement works/mines, etc.)
