


# Legal FRAMEWORK



Nigerian Oil & Gas Industry Content Development (NOGICD) Act (2010)

The NOGICD Act of 2010 establishes NCDMB as the sole agency of the Federal Government that is responsible for driving Nigerian Content in the oil and gas industry







#### World's largest free trade area

- Market size of 1.3 billion people across 55 countries
- Combined gross domestic product (GDP) of about US\$3.4 trillion.

### Holds 7% of the world's proven crude oil reserve^

 17 African countries have proven crude oil reserves of 125.3 billion barrels\*

#### Holds 13% of the world's proven gas reserves

 Combined African gas reserves is estimated to be about 620 trillion cubic feet) in 2021\*\*

### Availability of critical oil and gas infrastructure

- 2 FPSO Integration facilities (Angola and Nigeria)
- World-class fabrication yards
- World-class pipe mills etc.

### **Combined crude oil refining capacity of 1,752,500** bpd^^

• Dangote refinery of 650,000 bpd is expected to come onstream later

### Combined LNG liquefaction plant capacity of 71.1 mtpa

• With ongoing nd proposed LNG liquefaction projects, it is estimated to reach 144.8 mtpa by the year 2050


