PREPARING YOUR ABSTRACT SUBMISSION

DEADLINE EXTENDED

Your abstracts should be submitted no later than 8 March

The guidelines below will help you craft a successful application.

- Abstracts should be no more than 400 – 500 words and be written in English.
- Please do **NOT** send sales presentations or product pitches in: they will be rejected.
- You are welcome to include additional information, such as illustrations, graphs or tables, as attachments.
- Select one of the topics to indicate what best describes your abstract proposal.
- Please do not submit the same abstract more than once. If you believe your abstract is relevant to multiple topics or themes, please select the one that is the best fit.
- One person can submit multiple abstracts under the same topic or across multiple categories, but these must be substantially different from each other. Any abstracts that are considered to be derivatives of each other will not be considered.
- Abstracts should be accompanied by a presenter biography (no more than 250 words) and profile picture.

HOW TO ENSURE YOUR ABSTRACT IS SUCCESSFUL?

IMPACT: Does the topic have the potential to make a material impact on the energy industry of Suriname? Please include relevant results and/or case studies.

ORIGINALITY: Your abstract should demonstrate innovation and originality, and contain significant new knowledge, technical results or experience.

RELEVANT: How relevant is your submission to the current energy, oil & gas industry in Suriname? How interesting is the subject matter to the SEOGS audience and the industry overall?

Selection of Papers

The SEOGS Call for Speakers selection process begins once all papers have been submitted via the Call for Speakers online portal.

- The SEOGS Call for Speaker selection process begins once all papers have been submitted via our Call for speakers online portal. Your abstracts should be submitted no later than 23 February 2024.
- The submitted abstracts are reviewed by the advisory board against the eligibility criteria, assessing each eligible submission and producing an overall mark. The advisory board will meet to review the results.
- If your abstract is accepted, you will be notified by beginning of April 2024
- Authors whose abstracts are accepted will be required to reconfirm your interest in speaking. Applicants whose abstracts are not selected will be retained on a shortlist in case a selected applicant renounces the position.

- If your abstract is not selected for the conference, you'll be notified at the same time as those who have submitted selected papers.
- Detailed instructions on the preparation of the presentations will be sent to all authors once acceptance to speak has been received.
- The organiser assumes NO obligation for expenses by authors for travel, accommodation or other incidental expenses to attend and speak at the event.
- The lead presenter will receive a complementary technical pass with access to the technical conference, technical lunches and coffee breaks on day 2 and day 3, and evening networking functions and receptions on day 2 until day 4 and full access to the trade exhibition. Co-author are offered passes at a discounted rate.

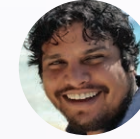
