



STATIC CARS

There are two official paddocks along the 60-mile route, where spectators are able to view veteran cars, cycles and motorcycles in close quarters from behind safety barriers.

Hyde Park, London Paddock: Hyde Park is the official start of the Run. Cars begin lining Serpentine Road from 6.00am with the last car departing at approximately 8.30am.

Madeira Drive, Brighton Paddock: Cars are expected to arrive in Brighton from 10.06am to the close of the Run at 4.30pm
