## TENDER VEHICLE PARKING

Madeira Drive - Thursday 30 October 2025 (12.00noon) - Monday 3 November 2025 (10.00am)

Telford Place Car Park - Sunday 2 November 2025 (7.30am-3.00pm)

For the purpose of the RM Sotheby's London to Brighton Veteran Car Run, a tender vehicle is deemed as any vehicle supporting, delivering or collecting a participating veteran car, cycle or motorcycle.

We are pleased to provide parking facilities, staffed by security personnel, for your tender vehicles in Crawley and Brighton.

## **TENDER PACK 1 - £95.00**

This pack is for a vehicle that has the capacity to transport one veteran vehicle.

## **TENDER PACK 2 - £180.00**

This pack is for a vehicle that has the capacity to transport up to two veteran vehicles.

## **TENDER PACK 3 - £500.00**

This pack is for a vehicle that has the capacity to transport three or more veteran vehicles.

Furthermore, tender vehicles are not able to enter Hyde Park. Veteran cars must be dropped off outside the park and be driven into the park via Victoria Gate or Alexandra Gate.

## LUGGAGE TRANSFER SERVICE

## **CONGESTION CHARGES AND ULEZ**

## IMPORTING YOUR VEHICLE AND TOW/TENDER VEHICLE

The **Congestion Charge** is a £15 daily charge if you drive within the Congestion Charge zone between 07:00-22:00 Monday to Friday and 12:00-18:00 on Saturday, Sunday and bank holidays.

Does the Congestion Charge apply to my veteran vehicle and tender vehicle?

All vehicles, regardless of age and whether they are registered in the UK or overseas must pay this charge **except when leaving London during the start of the Run.** You pay this via the Transport for London website (either with a TfL London Road User Charging account or direct payment on the site). However, if your veteran vehicle is being towed on a trailer, then only the towing vehicle is subject to Congestion Charge.

## ULEZ

The Ultra Low Emission Zone (ULEZ) operates 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. The zone operates across all London boroughs, and does not include the M25. If your vehicle doesn't meet the ULEZ emissions standards and isn't exempt, you need to pay a £12.50 daily charge to drive within the zone.

Does ULEZ apply to my veteran vehicle and tender vehicle?

ULEZ will apply to your road car and trailer while you are towing your veteran car through London and, once your veteran car is unloaded and driven on the road it will also apply. However, veteran vehicles are exempt from paying the charge, provided they are registered with ULEZ and tender vehicles may also be exempt, depending on their size and emissions. EU Registered Vehicles (including tow vehicles and trailers)

You must carry the following documentation when temporarily importing EU registered vehicles into the UK:

- · EU Driving Licence
- Vehicle Registration Document (for tow vehicle, trailer and Veteran car)
- Insurance Green Card (for tow vehicle, trailer, and Veteran car)
- C110 Form (for both Veteran car and tow vehicle. Download at: https://www.gov.uk/government publications/import-and-export-temporary-admission-notice-of-arrival-of-a-non-eu-private-motor-vehicle-c110)

The C110 form must be completed before you arrive into the UK. Print out two copies of the form, sending one off to the UK address given on the website and keeping one with each applicable vehicle.

EU Registered vehicles will NOT require an ATA Carnet for temporary UK import.

#### **Trailers**

Trailers do not have to be registered separately. All trailers must be properly insured to be towed on the road in the UK and be in a roadworthy condition.

#### Overseas (Non-EU) Registered Vehicles

You must carry the following documentation when temporarily importing overseas (non-EU) registered vehicles into the UK:

- Overseas Driving Licence
- · Vehicle Registration Document
- Insurance Green Card

Non-EU registered vehicles entering the UK / Europe from overseas will require a customs entry on arrival. Your shipping agent will be able to provide further information on this procedure.
