Keeping control of your car on public roads is vitally important at all times. It's more than a polite request from me to be cautious when required by our marshals – it's a key stipulation of taking part.

It's also essential you watch our Run safety film, and we've put it online for you so it's easy to do just that.

Veteran cars may not always be swift, but they can be more temperamental than many. We depend on your expertise to make sure yours is running – and stopping – to the best of its ability by carrying out thorough road testing and servicing before the Run. We recommend as many shakedown as you can.

Upon confirmation of your vehicle's acceptance into the Run you will be sent an official acceptance email.




For the purpose of the RM Sotheby's London to Brighton Veteran Car Run, a tender vehicle is deemed as any vehicle supporting, delivering or collecting a participating veteran car, cycle or motorcycle.

We are pleased to provide parking facilities, staffed by security personnel, for your tender vehicles in Crawley and Brighton.

TENDER PACK 1 – £95.00

This pack is for a vehicle that has the capacity to transport one veteran vehicle.

TENDER PACK 2 – £190.00

This pack is for a vehicle that has the capacity to transport up to two veteran vehicles.

TENDER PACK 3 – £550.00

This pack is for a vehicle that has the capacity to transport three or more veteran vehicles.
