

MEDIA ACCREDITATION TERMS AND CONDITIONS

For Journalists, Content Creators, Photographers, Videographers & Film Crews

- Media accreditation is required for all journalists, producers, content creators, photographers, videographers, film and broadcast crews who wish to attend the 2025 FutureAg Expo powered by AGRITECHNICA to take photographs, recordings or videos for editorial use, including those creating or recording content for partners, sponsors and other commercially affiliated third parties.
- 2. To be eligible for media accreditation, you must submit a media accreditation application.
- 3. All accredited media will receive a media accreditation pass, which is only for use when working in an official media capacity covering the events of the FutureAg Expo.
- 4. Applicants must outline in their application if they wish to attend both the exhibit and / or paid conference program. The two-day conference Media Accreditation approval is at the discretion of the FutureAg Expo media team.
- 5. Accredited media are not guaranteed access to all event venues, access is at the discretion of event manager.
- 6. Due to the number of media accreditation applications received from working media we are unable to accommodate every application.
- 7. For those unable to receive accreditation, we will be providing a link to Dropbox folder which will be populated with expo and conference shots.
- 8. Please note that accreditation misuse of any kind will result in the cancellation of accreditation.
