

Mark is also a seasoned law enforcement officer and trainer, having spent twenty years with the Hobbs New Mexico Police Department in numerous roles including Patrol Officer, Detective for the Gang and Narcotics unit, Supervisor of the Crime Prevention Division, Field Training Officer, Honor Guard Commander, and Entry Team Leader and Tactical Sergeant of the S.W.A.T. unit. During this time, his responsibilities also included the development and implementation of security policies and procedures and security awareness programs for the Community of Hobbs. Upon retiring from the police department, he leveraged his training background to implement security policies, procedures and training programs for the oil and gas industry, then later worked as an instructor for the DHS, training 3,000 armed pilots to defend against acts of terrorism.
