Ken Jefferson Inducted into the Atlanta Hospitality Hall of Fame

Atlanta Convention & Visitors Bureau (ACVB) gathered with Atlanta's hospitality leaders at the new College Football Hall of Fame on the GWCCA campus, for the 16th Annual Atlanta Hospitality Hall of Fame. The reception honored individuals who have made outstanding contributions to the growth and well-being of Atlanta's hospitality industry.

This year's inductees included the GWCCA's own Ken Jefferson, Event Services Manager at the Georgia Dome.

Jefferson, a sporting events legend, has a nearly 30 year career in the convention, sports, and entertainment industries. He has held his current post as event services manager at the Georgia Dome for more than 20 years. During his tenure, Jefferson has successfully coordinated and managed two Super Bowls, the 2006 Nokia Sugar Bowl, the 1996 Centennial Olympic Games, USA Track & Field Indoor Championships, two ACC Men's basketball tournaments, multiple Chick-fil-A

Kick-Off and Bowl Games, multiple FCC basketball and football tournaments, three NCAA Final Four tournaments, and 20 seasons of Atlanta Falcons football. Jefferson has worked as a consultant for the last 12 Super Bowl games and was also a member of the NCAA's Facility Coordination Group for three years. Prior to his work at the Georgia Dome, Jefferson served as the senior event coordinator at the Georgia World Congress Center. Jefferson is a member of the International Association of Venue Management. He is a Georgia native and holds a Bachelor's degree from Morris Brown College.
