With the first day of build-up at IBC2025 only days away, below is your final update on pre-show logistics and onsite support this year:

Pre-Show:**Final tasks:**

- Ensure you have completed all your tasks in your E-Zone - <https://reg.ibc.org/e-zone> - including completing your profile.
- It is essential that every stand completes their Health & Safety Declaration. You can complete this form here - [IBC2025 -Health and Safety Declaration-Stand Activities Form](#).
- Register your staff – please register all your stand exhibitor names in advance of the show. You can do this via the Registration tab in your E-Zone. This will remain available to use until the end of the final show day. You can register additional names until the end of the last show day. A pre-show email will be sent to all registered exhibitors. This year every badge has a free GVB travel passes included. See below for further information.
- [RAI Webshop](#) is still open. A limited range of items are still available to order including on stand catering.

There are a number of ways we will support you onsite at IBC this year:

If you have any problems with the RAI stand orders such as power/internet/catering or have a stand built by the RAI – shell scheme including enhanced and CE packages, Pods, Future Tech or meeting suites, etc – you can contact the RAI via:

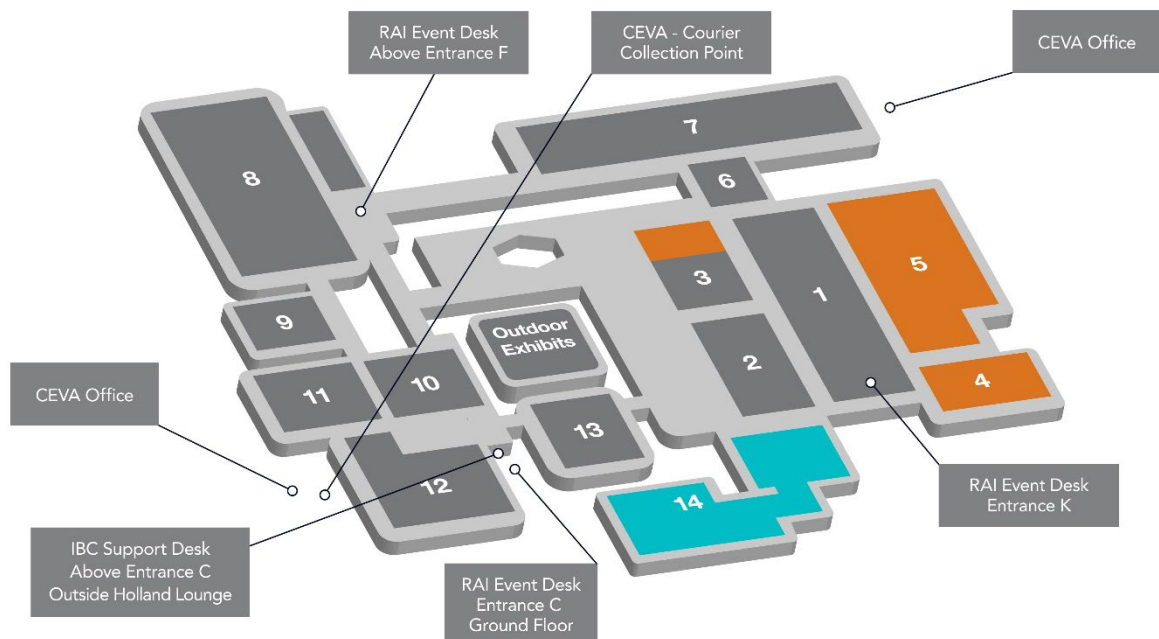
Ordering:

You can still make orders onsite via the [RAI Webshop](#), at the RAI Event Desks or via the RAI Call Centre (details above).

Stand power switched off overnight:

Stand power will be switched off in every hall over night from 20:00 on Friday 12 September and will be switched back on at 07:30 on Saturday 13 September morning. Stand power will be switched off every evening during the show days. **PLEASE ENSURE YOU POWER DOWN ALL STAND EVERY EVENING OF THE SHOW TO AVOID TRIPPING THE FUSES AND STOPPING YOUR STAND POWER BEING SWITCHED BACK ON.** If you have ordered 24hr power (overnight power), your stand power will not be affected.

The power will remain on overnight in every hall from Thursday 11 September to Friday 12 September.

Unofficial Wi-Fi networks will be monitored and are at risk of being switched off if these are deemed to affect the RAI Wi-Fi /internet.

Health & Safety at the Show:

You will need to ensure that you have the correct safety equipment – hard hat, site boots and hi viz – before you access the halls during build-up and breakdown. Badges and registration:

Please ensure that all of your stand staff are registered before the show. Your Exhibitor stand badges will allow you access during build-up, show days and breakdown. These can be collected from a number of locations. Please ensure that you and your collect team collect their badges in advance of the opening show day. The entrances will be busy with visitors collecting their badges and entering the show so ensure you have your badge in advance of this. Please note that there is free parking available when using the RAI car parks to load/unload. You will need to register for a RAI Work Pass, which you scan when leaving the car parks. Register here - [Event Information \(rai.nl\)](#)

IBC2026 Rebooking:

IBC2026 rebooking: Please be aware that rebooking for IBC2026 runs onsite at IBC2025 from Saturday 13 September. You should have already received your appointment time via email. Security:

IBC provide security cover in all areas of the RAI Amsterdam occupied by IBC (including the Outdoor Exhibits) from build-up through to breakdown. However, IBC are not responsible for exhibitors' equipment.

Theft Prevention: It is strongly advised not to leave equipment unattended on stands. It is also advised not to leave valuable items unattended and wherever possible, laptops and computers to be taken off-site overnight, during show days and secured with appropriate locks during build-up and breakdown. Hiring lockers or having lockable storage rooms on your stand is strongly advised.

If any thefts do occur, please report these to RAI Security ASAP who will advise on the reporting process with the local Police. All thefts must be reported at the time they occur in order for the RAI and IBC to be able to liaise with the Police.

IMPORTANT: Exhibitors are reminded that overnight stand security may be required for equipment left on the stand after the close of the show on **Monday 15 September** – this must be ordered in advance. Exhibitors are responsible for equipment on their stand from delivery until collection by CEVA Showfreight.

GVB travel passes:

Underscoring our commitment to sustainability, all IBC2025 badges will include an integrated GVB QR code for trams, buses, and metro! Providing frictionless access to the city's GVB public transport network and eliminating the need for non-recyclable ticket printing, you will be able to move seamlessly between the RAI and central Amsterdam, simply by scanning the QR code on your pass!

As part of our ongoing commitment to sustainability and reducing the environmental impact of a live show, IBC will no longer provide complimentary airport shuttle services from IBC2025. Dutch Rail (NS) offers quick, cheap and regular trains from Schiphol to the RAI Station, and tickets can be purchased at the airport. Please note that Dutch Rail (NS) isn't covered by the GVB passes.
