If you are listed as the **Primary Exhibition Coordinator (PEC)** for your company, you will have received an email from noreply@reg.ibc.org with your login details. Please check your **junk or spam folders** if you do not see it.

Accessing the E-Zone

To help you locate your login email:

- **Email address:** noreply@reg.ibc.org
- **Sender name:** IBC2026 (No Reply)
- **Subject line:** *IBC2026 E-Zone invitation; activate your account*

If this is your first time logging in, please use the **'forgot password'** option to create your password.

- Review **Task Management** and begin your personalised exhibitor tasks. This section contains key mandatory tasks for all exhibitors.

The **Primary Exhibition Coordinator (PEC)** can also add additional users to the E-Zone, ensuring the relevant members of your team have access.
