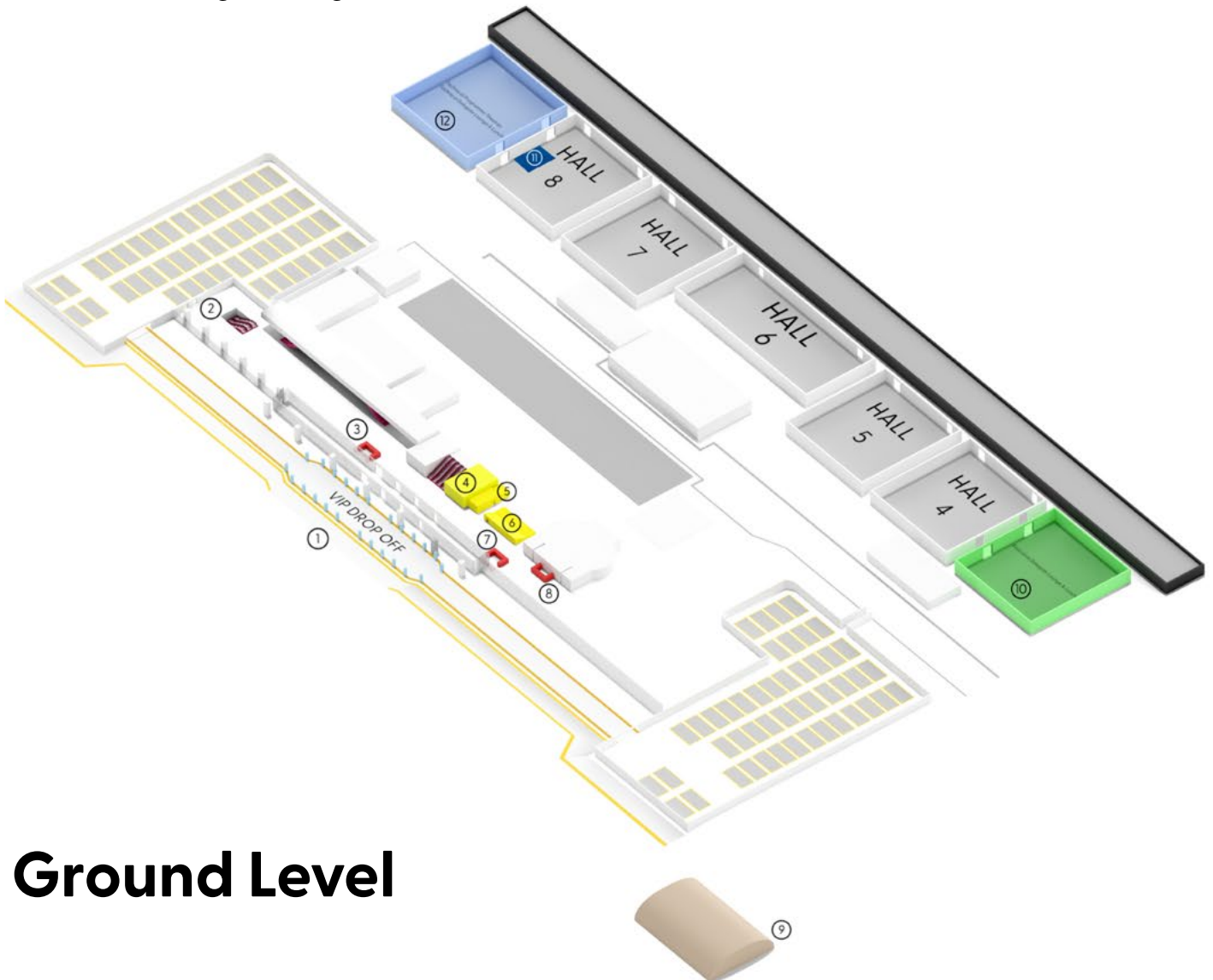


Basement Level - Parking

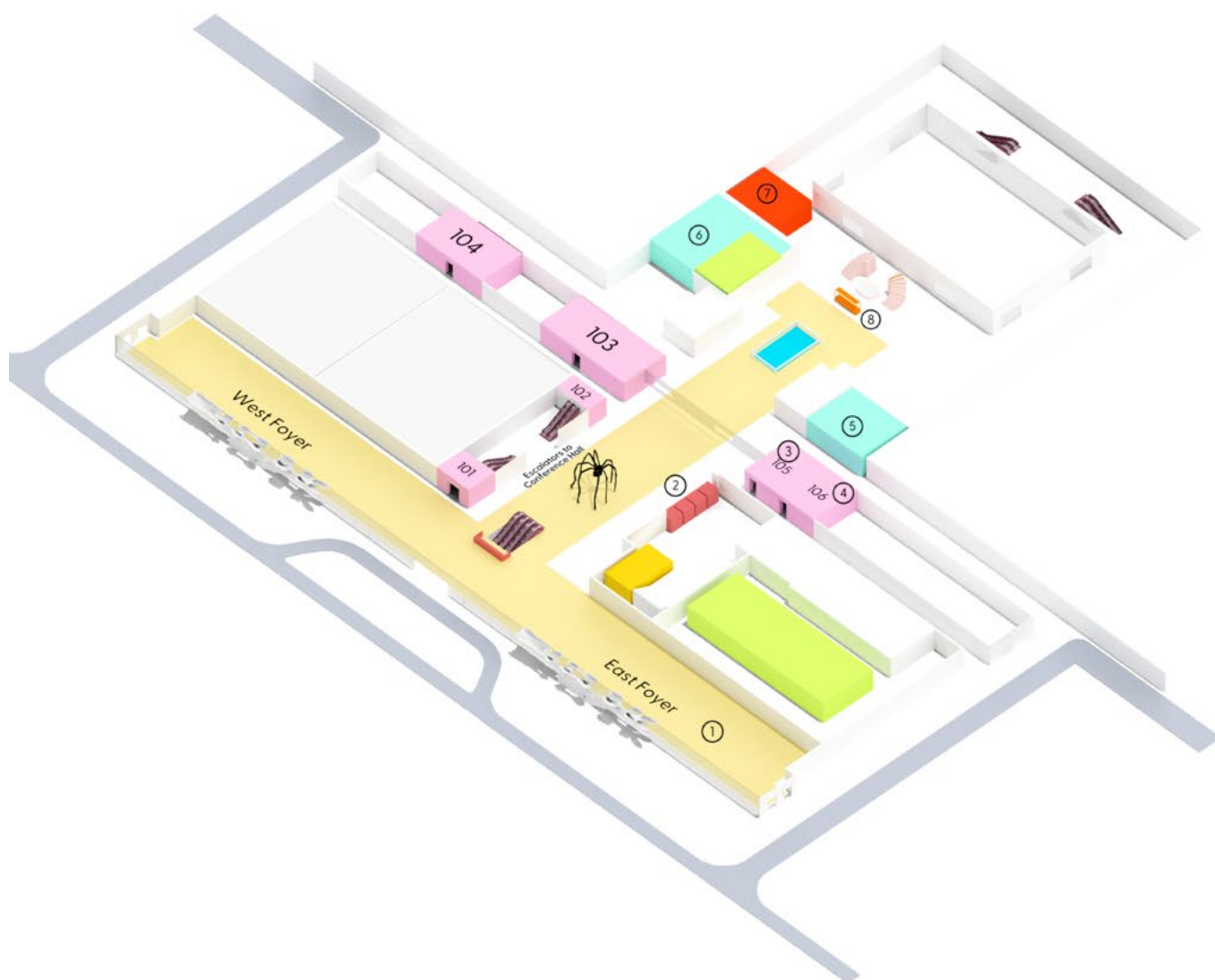

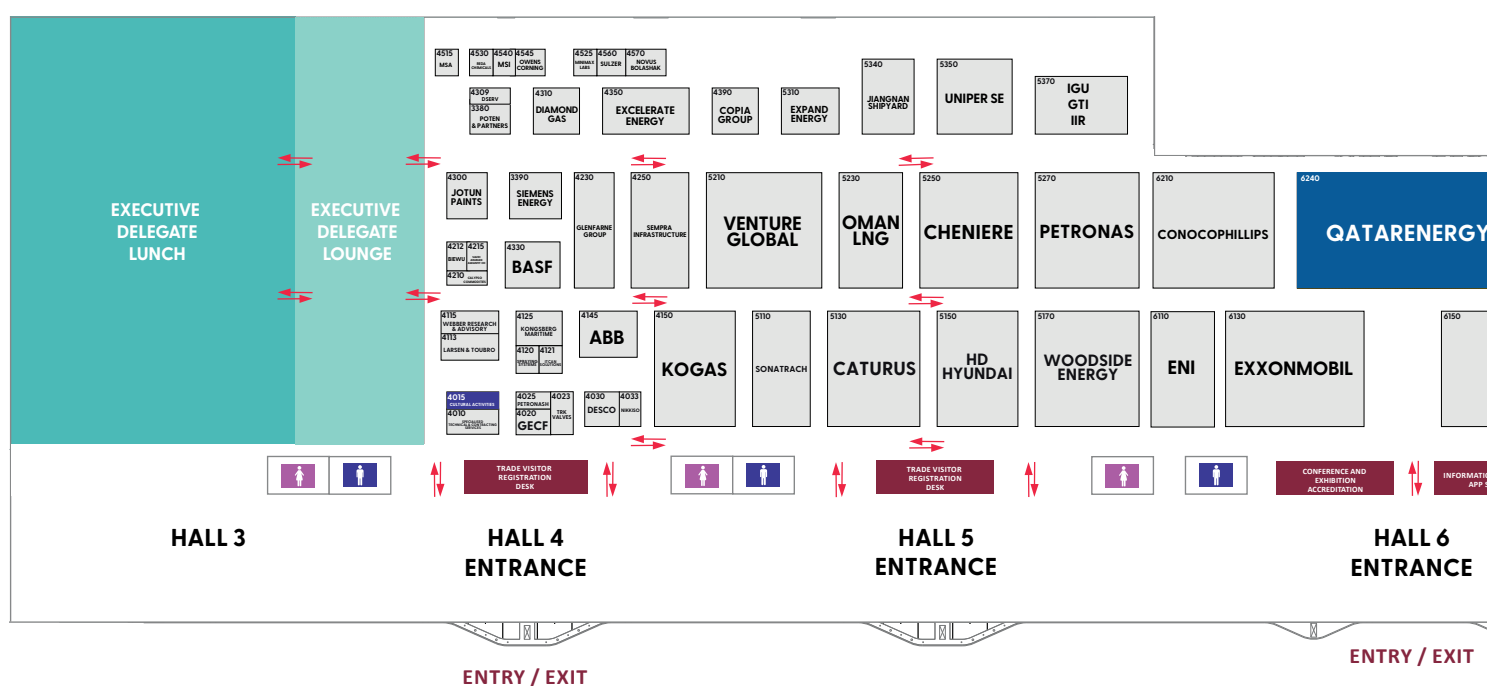

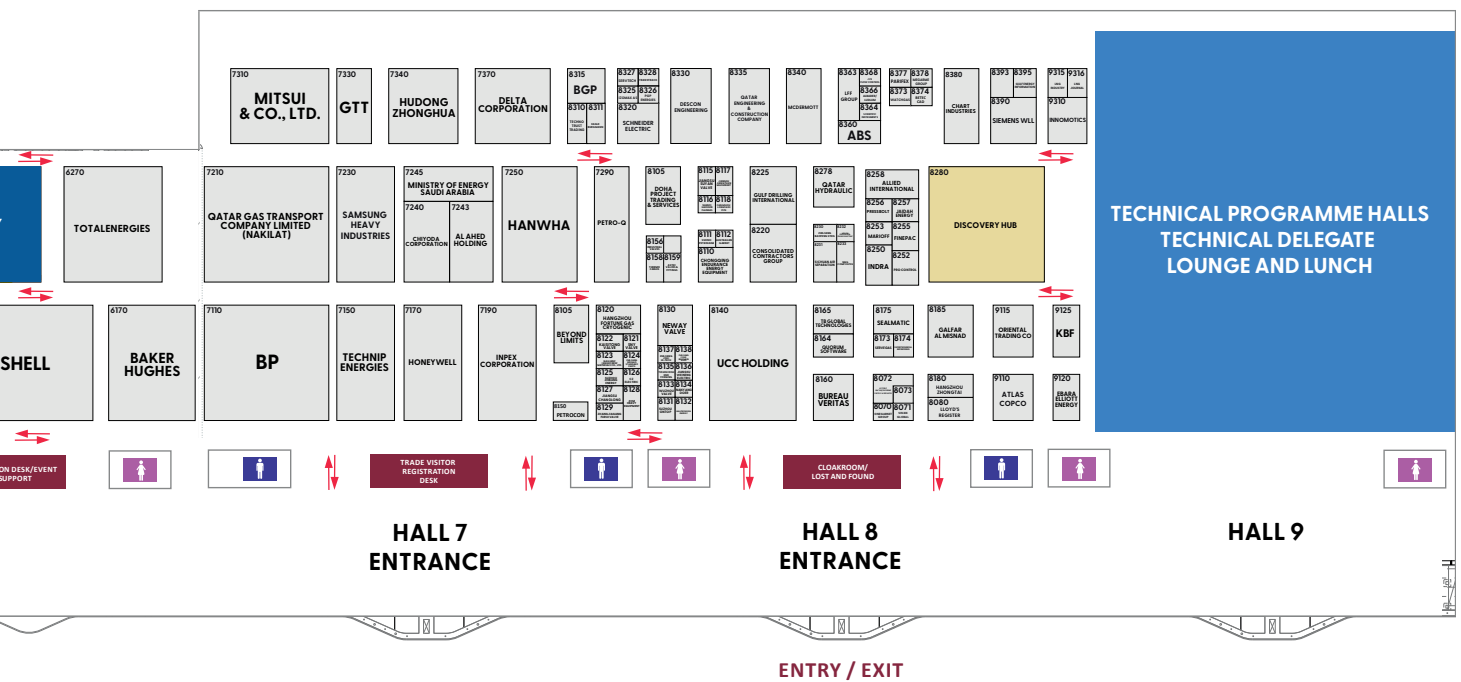


EXHIBITION FLOOR PLAN

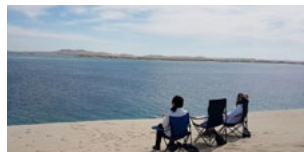

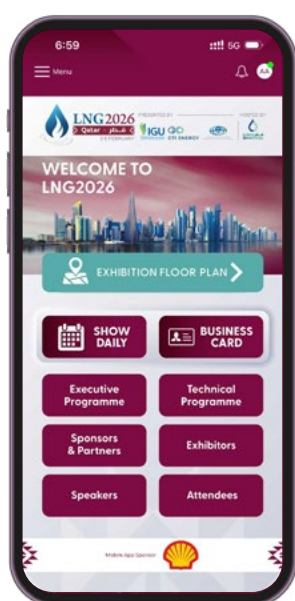

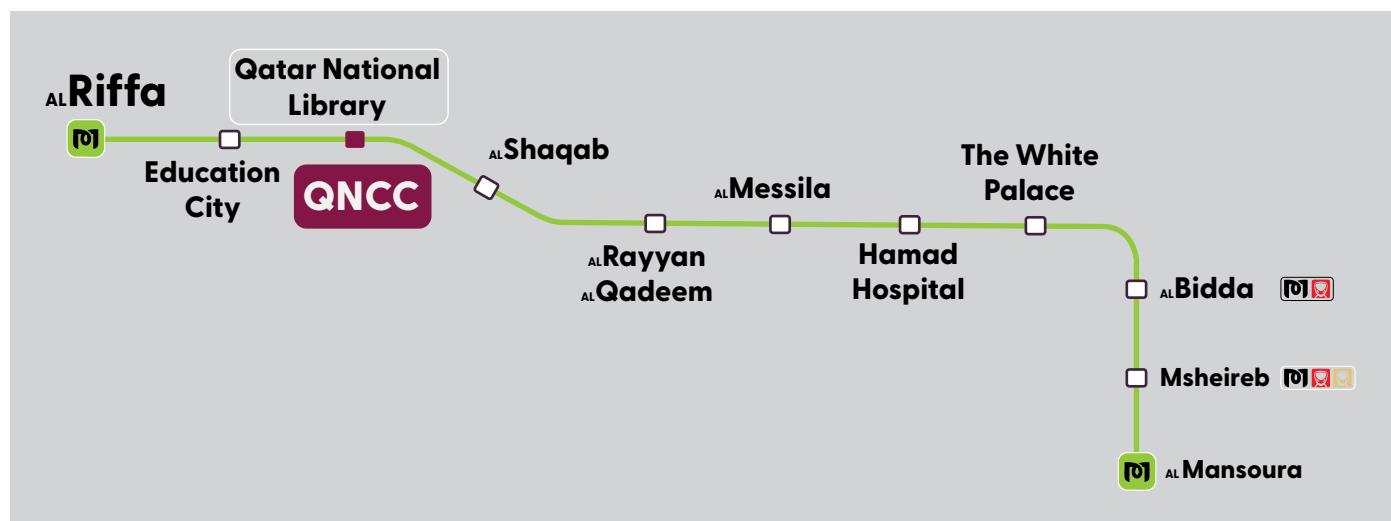
