We have put together this guide to help you find your way around site and make your journey as simple as possible.

The Voyage Control vehicle access system is used for:



Build

Open day delivery (prior to show open time)



Restocking (post-show close time)

Please note: The Voyage Control system is not used for breakdown.

All vehicles unloading, whether cars or lorries, need to obtain an Event Delivery Pass in advance using our online delivery system powered by Voyage Control at: voyagecontrol.com/necbirmingham



Alwavs display your pass for the duration of your stay.

Who uses Voyage Control?

Stand Contractors Including all subcontractors and/ or hired transport

Shell Exhibitors

Space Only

Who doesn't have to use Voyage Control?

Any exhibitors and contractors who do not require vehicle access to offload at the rear of the halls can park in the outer car parks during the build and breakdown at no charge.



Couriers

Multi-drop courier delivery drivers should head to the lorry park for processing but do not need to book via Voyage Control.

Organiser official contractors

Contractors and Exhibitors who do not wish to offload

How does it work?

It is recommended that you use Google Chrome or Microsoft Edge as the preferred browsers.

- Pre-book your slot prior to arrival onsite via logging onto the NEC Voyage **Control System**
- Click to download a copy of our User Guide
- When you arrive on site, follow the digital directional signs to the relevant lorry park for your event.
- Drive in and show your pre-booked printed pass.





Important information

- Overnight parking on operational lorry parks is not permitted unless by prior agreement with the NEC.
- Only vehicles who have purchased Exhibitor Advantage Parking for the open period can park at the rear of the halls – this is only available for cars and people carriers. For further information on this product please refer to our website: thenec.co.uk/exhibitors/ exhibitor-parking
- Within the offloading area there will be lots of vehicle and people movements with forklifts also operating, so please be vigilant and take care. Everyone's safety is important please report any concerns to the nearest traffic or security officer.
- There's a speed limit of 15mph within the inner area.



- High visibility clothing must be worn at all times in the offloading areas. Vehicles must not park on yellow hatch markings unless directed to do so by a Traffic Officer. Vehicles must never park on red hatch markings.
- Children under the age of 16 are not permitted in the halls during build and breakdown.

Build

- Vehicles over two tonnes will be allowed two hours.
- Articulated vehicles will be allowed three hours.
- Exhibitors are advised that the delivery time will commence via ANPR on entry to the inner area (once through the gate check point). Please note if you book multiple slots for the same vehicle, you must exit the inner area and return to the lorry park for check-in and re-entry to inner area.
- Head to the relevant offloading area, it's recommended you are aware of your stand number & nearest VE door to assist in getting you as close as possible (subject to space being available).
- to make space for other exhibitors.


• Cars and vehicles up to two tonnes will be allowed access one hour from the time of entry.



• Once you have unloaded, please take your vehicle back to the free outer area car park,

- Exhibitors should ensure that all hire transport drivers are advised of these procedures, prior to their arrival at The NEC.
- Exhibitors should ensure that their appointed stand contractor and sub-contractors are advised of these arrangements to reduce delays when arriving at the NEC lorry park.
- Please note: Failure to remove your vehicle in the allotted time to the outer car parks may incur a penalty charge. If you over-run your time slot, please speak to a traffic officer or the organisers.

Build (Deposit System day)

- When a deposit system is in use, you still need to book all deliveries as outlined above using the online booking system.
- On a deposit system day, failure to remove your vehicle from the inner area unloading areas within the allocated delivery time, will result in a £ 100 charge.
- Exhibitors are advised that the delivery time will commence via ANPR on entry to the inner area via the relevant gate.

Open Day Deliveries (Restocking)

- During the show open days, vehicle access will be granted up to 30 minutes prior to show open.
- There may also be the option for vehicles to have access to the rear of the hall post show to restock stands.
- Both access options will need to be booked in via Voyage Control by selecting the available time slots.
- Arrangements are specific to each event if available and are normally detailed in the Exhibitor Manual.
- Your vehicle must be removed to the outer car park or offsite as soon as the delivery has been made.
- Vehicle access to the rear of the halls is not immediate following show close, you will be advised once access is permitted.


Breakdown

- Our Voyage Control System does not apply for the show breakdown procedure.
- Breakdown instructions will be issued by the show organiser, once the show is open.
- Forklifts are not permitted to operate in the halls until it is safe to do so and has been agreed by the organiser and NEC.

Cars:

- On the breakdown day, please park in the allocated exhibitor car parks.
- Following show close, any cars or cars with trailers will be granted access to the rear of halls via the relevant gate.
- Any cars arriving before the show breakdown time will be turned away.

Commercial vehicles:



- Vehicles will be queued in lines by hall number on a first come first served basis.
- Vehicles can then park free of charge in the queue through the day until breakdown commences.
- Vehicles will be released down to the halls on a first-come-first-serve basis, once all the cars have parked up and if space is available.

Follow the electronic signage to specific parking locations for build and breakdown vehicles.

All build and breakdown vehicles need to follow our electronic directional signage for the dedicated lorry parks in use (either South, North 1a or North 12).




Handy tips
