




London Overground

Nearest Station: Kensington Olympia.

Direct services run from Clapham Junction, Balham, East Croydon, Shepherd's Bush, Watford Junction, Milton Keynes Central, Willesden Junction, West Hampstead and Stratford.



London Underground



District Line

There is only a District line service from Earls Court on weekends. Please check before you travel.

When travelling from Monday to Friday, you should change at West Brompton for a 2 minute Overground train to Kensington (Olympia). Alternatively, West Kensington is an 8 minute walk away, and High Street Kensington is a 4 minute bus ride or 12 minute walk away.

Central Line

Change at Shepherd's Bush for a 2 minute Overground train to Kensington (Olympia).



Piccadilly Line

Baron's Court is a 9 minute walk away from Olympia London.

Hammersmith & City Line Hammersmith Station is a 5 minute bus ride or 15 minute walk away.



Circle Line
