

# TRANSFORMING FOOD SYSTEMS

## PARK ROYAL NET ZERO

**Brunel University London** is leading a £2.6 m research grant, **Park Royal Net Zero**, to transform the food supply systems operating within West London's Park Royal Industrial Estate.

Park Royal, known as 'London's Kitchen' hosts over 500 businesses in the food and drink sector, producing 30% of London's food and drink, contributing circa £8 bn to the economy.

**Park Royal Net Zero** will address industry innovation challenges:

- Reduction of energy use in the food supply chain.
- Innovation, capacity building and increased productivity.
- Minimisation and valorisation of food waste.
- Increasing uptake of low energy and advanced technologies in food.



### Aiming to:

- Strengthen research and innovation infrastructure supporting Park Royal and the food sector more widely.
- Become an exemplar and catalyst for carbon reduction.

Brunel and its partners will help industry address challenges through:

- Energy and/or Innovation Audits.
- Staff Exchange and Mobility.
- Industrial Test Beds and Demonstrators.
- Research and Prototype Development Projects.
