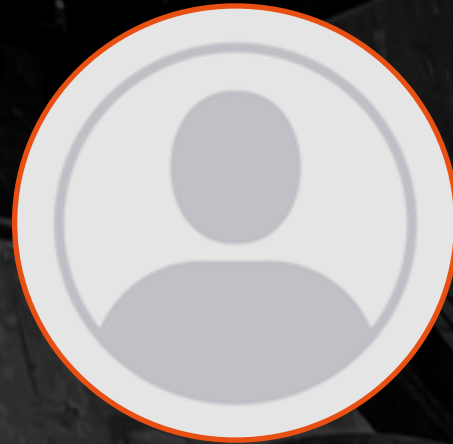

Join your fellow attendees on a unique visit of ArcelorMittal's Steelanol, a new era of recycling carbon-rich industrial gases and transform into advanced sustainable ethanol to further reduce their carbon emissions. This project is a European first and puts steel at the heart of the circular economy.

Attendees will have the opportunity to see, first-hand, a pilot project that will allow for the capture and reuse of a portion of carbon emitted by the steel industry without need to rebuild the BAT (Best Available Technologies) steel plant while supplying the transport sector with high grade biofuel.
