Renovation Project County Hall

Our County Hall expansion has seen 40,000 sqft of disused space transformed into a **workspace for 100+ sustainable businesses**.

Building from the ground up, this project was an exciting opportunity for us to create a space that is as unique as the members it serves.

Working with our funders; Big Issue Invest, London Borough of Lambeth and County Hall Arts, the space has been tailored specifically to the needs of our members, whilst acting as an example of innovative and sustainable renovation.

Whilst embedding our story into the history of this building, we also wanted to pave the way for its future. In the decade of green growth, it seemed fitting that the next chapter in this iconic building's long history should be one of sustainability.



We are working to create **a net zero workspace** for our members.

We are constantly iterating our practices to make the running of our workspaces as sustainable as possible; from our daily operations to our portfolio of suppliers, specifically selected for their sustainable impact credentials.

As part of the design and fitout of the fifth floor project, we followed a re-use first policy alongside a selection of low carbon materials.


We worked with a number of member companies in the building technology sector, who advised us on everything from tracking and minimising our waste production to our heating and cooling system.

THE PLANET IS NOT A SOFA.

The way most offices are furnished today is shaped by yesterday's ways of doing business, with little to no focus on climate. So when needs change, workspaces change, and furniture is either thrown away or stored in the basement.
