As a means of supporting you in completing this application form we have compiled a short guide to help you.

Application Form

We are looking for students who fall into one of the below three categories;

Have founded or co-founded their own start-up

Are successfully running and growing their own business

Are in the early stages of starting up and putting a business plan into practice

Top tips for completing your application form:

Carefully review each question and try to give as much detail as possible in each answer. Avoid unnecessary detail, focus your answers on the exceptional aspects of your achievements. The word limits are not indicative of how much you must write and should only be used as a guide. However you must not exceed the maximum word count – quality precedes quantity.

Only an application form submitted online will be accepted and remember to save your progress as often as possible.

Finally, before submitting your application please ensure you check:

- Spelling and grammar
- You have answered all questions completely and to the best of your ability
- Your contact and personal details
- You have signed the terms and conditions
