

ICOMAT announces FACTORY III first facility in USA

ICOMAT is opening **Factory III** in Dayton, Ohio, marking the company's first manufacturing and R&D facility on American soil and a decisive step in its mission to redefine composites manufacturing globally.

The Dayton facility, located in Vandalia, adjacent to the heart of America's aerospace and defense ecosystem, will bring ICOMAT's patented Rapid Tow Shearing (RTS) technology to the US market for the first time. Factory III gives ICOMAT a full production footprint in the United States, capable of delivering end-to-end composite manufacturing, from initial development and design through to production, directly to US defense and aerospace customers.

The location is deliberate. Dayton sits at the center of America's defense manufacturing resurgence, within reach of Wright-Patterson Air Force Base and a concentration of OEMs building the next generation of aircraft, drones, and advanced platforms. ICOMAT's presence here means US customers get the same zero-compromise capability and speed that built the company's reputation in UK and Europe, without the friction of cross-border supply chains.

With Factory III, ICOMAT now operates a multi-continent manufacturing network spanning three Factories across the UK (Gloucester, Swindon) and US (Dayton, OH).

The expansion reinforces a simple commitment: **wherever our customers build the future, we will be there to manufacture it.**
