- Minor injuries can be addressed by the reception desk staff and notification to the Exhibit Manager on site.
- If the injury is to yourself, notify Human Resources lead for your function/ country and your direct leadership. If the sustained injury is to an attendee, the exhibit management staff will manage any necessary documentation with the attendee, Siemens Healthineers, and the show organizer.
