Information for Occupational Health Providers

SEQOHS is recognised as the occupational health industry standard. It's used in both public and private sectors, by in-house and contracted occupational health services. SEQOHS accreditation provides independent assessment of providers using agreed standards of safety, effectiveness and quality.

This leaflet explains the benefits of SE00HS accreditation, eligibility criteria and the registration pathway for providers.

What are the benefits of SEQOHS accreditation?

- Benchmarking to promote safe, effective and good quality services
- Assurance for your clients and potential clients that you have been independently assessed for the quality and value of your services
- Listing as an accredited provider at www.seqohs.org
- Promotion of the services that you offer at www.seqohs.org
- Use of the SEQOHS quality mark on your website and documentation
- Continuous improvement through support and advice from SE00HS
- Opportunities to showcase your achievements and network with others at the annual SEQOHS Best Practice conference

Am I eligible to register for SEQOHS accreditation?

To register you must...

- Be an occupational health service provider of any size, including single handed occupational health professionals, in any sector.
- Be based in the United Kingdom or Ireland.
- Have access (via employment or a contractual arrangement) to an occupational physician listed as an accredited specialist in occupational medicine on the General Medical Council's Specialist Register.
- Employ a health professional in a senior leadership position who is registered with the relevant regulator (GMC, NMC, HCPC) and who has a recognised qualification in occupational health.
- Have been established and operational for at least 12 months.

How do I achieve SEQOHS accreditation?

- Register
- 2 Self-assess, using our guidance and templates
- 3 Upload evidence that you meet the standards for review by SEQOHS
- 4 Have an accreditation e-visit
- 5 Achieve accreditation or receive guidance on any further work required to achieve accreditation
