The 4T System has been designed as a reconfigurable product. When designing the 4T, Hee Welling and the Icons team took a holistic approach in its design – making sure that it was as sustainable as it is practical. Being reconfigurable means it can be altered, added to, or subtracted to create a new configuration – one that can be taken to the next location when the company expands. With some consideration, there is now no need to replace the product with something entirely new.

Hee Welling adds, "The system is constructed in a very sustainable manner, and there are no limits. We separated out the materials. None of the components are made in a way that they can't be detached afterwards. This makes it is a long-lasting system – you can always add or remove different panels which helps change the expression and the functionality. This system can be used for many years and hopefully passed on to the next owner of the location or the office – or taken with you."

"I like to think of the 4T as a deck of cards. No matter how many times you shuffle them, you will still create something unique and personal to you.
