MATERIALS

Designed specifically for high use applications, Link has an integral steel frame which sits inside a moulded polyurethane seat panel. Powder coated or stainless steel legs are attached to the frame creating a modular unit with a 25 year guarantee.



COLOURS

Link is offered in any RAL colour, making it perfect for any type of educational, corporate or public environments. The legs are available in powder coated matt black or in stainless steel.



ACCESSORIES

The modular design incorporates a range of optional accessories, including dividers, tables and charging points available with all international sockets and USB A or C.
