# Kirkby Design Partners with COAT Paints for their First-Ever Paint Collection.







Complementary

A clever green greige with an effortless feel.

Straddling warm white and a fresh clay green, it has a subtle depth that brings balance. Pair it with crisp whites for a fresh look or deeper earthy tones for a grounded, organic feel.

Contrasting

Soft and inviting, this soft blush feels intimate.

Sitting between a warm neutral and a gentle pastel, it's colourful without feeling overpowering. Ideal for a light-filled bedroom or a welcoming hallway.



#### **HEARTS**

Embrace the tactility of Hearts with these effortlessly rich paint pairings. Deep red and yellow undertones create a sense of warmth that's confident, without shouting.

#### MAJESTY'S MOOD

Complementary

Majesty's Mood is a contemporary taupe with an easygoing feel.

Blending beige and greige, it's effortlessly versatile and works well across a range of spaces.

#### HEIR BRUSH

Contrasting

A sun-baked shade that lands somewhere between burnt caramel and rich ochre.

It's bold enough to add character but still easy to live with particularly when balanced with yellow-based neutrals.



### ZODIAC

The grounded beige of Title Pending creates the perfect contrast to the Zodiac fabric, with its contemporary take on forest green. Complement with Gown & Out for a refined biophillic look.



#### GOWN & OUT

Complementary

A classic forest green with a contemporary edge. It's confident, without even trying.

With just the right amount of black pigment to create depth and knock out any brashness, this green feels bold without being overpowering.



# TITLE PENDING

Contrasting

An easygoing tan with a sophisticated depth.

Sitting between beige and rich caramel, it's a versatile neutral that works anywhere — with a put-together feel that doesn't try too hard.



#### **MERLON**

The butter yellow of Queen's Gambit pairs perfectly with Merlon fabric in Custard for a tonal look. Or, contrast with Blue Blood for a dramatic yet perfectly hushed effect.

## QUEEN'S GAMBIT

Complementary

Understated yet calculated, Queen's Gambit is a warm butter yellow with a timeless appeal.

Sitting between a creamy neutral and a brighter yellows, it brings a quiet joy to any space and works particularly well in big flood-lit rooms.




#### **BLUE BLOOD**

Contrasting

Blue Blood is a commanding blue that feels properly regal.

Pitched close to a more vivid cerulean blue, we've added black pigment to knock a little of the vibrancy out. Pair it with crisp whites for a sharp contrast, or deep ochre shades for an opulent feel.



#### REGAL

Regal by name, regal by nature. This glamorous basket weave is a blend of the past and future. Combine effortlessly with Palace PR for a tonal scheme, or go bold with Always Guilded.



#### PALACE PR

Complementary

A toned-down red with a warm, earthy vibe.

Balancing terracotta and red quite cleverly, it's a hushed red that's rich enough but it doesn't scream at you. Perfect for colour-drenching for a dramatic cocoon effect, or for picking out accent trim to create contrast.



#### **ALWAYS GUILDED**

Contrasting

A rich blend of antique gold and earthy green give this shade a uniqueness that's not for the feint hearted.

An unseen blend of aged brass and olive, it's green with a timeworn feel. Full of character, Always Guided is a confident colour with a golden edge.



### SCROLL

Embrace the tactility of Scroll with these effortlessly rich paint pairings. Deep red and yellow undertones create a sense of warmth that's confident, without shouting.



#### LADY LORE

Complementary

Lady Lore is a warm, storied gold.
