


### **About Tatie Lou**

Louise is a printed textile designer and an expert in the Japanese art of Shibori, who, one day, transferred her work to wallpaper. The rest, as they say, is history.

Inspired by the brilliance of Mother Nature, the magic of India, and the beauty of ancient Japanese crafts, Louise creates her designs by combining a mixture of shibori dyeing, hand drawing and painting. Each print is digitised and transformed into a range of different colourways before being applied to wallpapers, fabrics, cushions and lampshades, as well as blankets and table linens.
