To do so, you have to understand that the best design is that which does not impede us and brings together areas, people, conversations and ideas. Noray is conceived to create flexible and versatile spaces, areas within other areas based on a friendly design with slender, rounded figures that also offer perfect sound-absorbing acoustics.

The elements that go to make Noray are simple, independent screens with curved aluminium or wooden legs or with unlimitedly connectable wheels, which may include magnetic boards and even high tables for occasional uses.

Pattio's textile finishes with Noray give it something extra when it comes to quality and aesthetics. Its wide variety of fabrics allow you to create innumerable versions thanks to the combination with legs and joining pieces. The panel-joining system has been designed as simply as possible, hence design and originality have not been neglected. By "tying" a connector to the knob and crossing it in an "X" shape to the next panel, we achieve joints we can articulate at an infinite number of angles. Moreover, the panels in their single-colour version have no hand, so they are reversible.

In short, Noray is the design solution Pattio has devised for open space offices or living rooms where various activities take place such as meetings, telephone calls, videoconferences, operational work...Noray offers an optimal sound-absorbing solution thanks to how its panels are built; thanks to the absence of metal interiors, it helps absorb and cause an acoustic improvement in the space.
