Each tile begins with optimised existing materials, giving resources a longer and more purposeful life. As a result, Giano delivers a durable terrazzo surface while actively reducing waste.

This approach shifts the role of terrazzo within contemporary architecture. Instead of treating materials as finite, Giano treats them as part of an ongoing cycle. The process preserves performance while lowering environmental impact. Consequently, designers can specify a robust surface solution without compromise. At the same time, projects gain a material story rooted in responsibility and forward-thinking production.

Giano also brings a clear visual identity. The composition reflects the layered nature of reused materials, creating subtle variation and depth across each tile. However, the surface remains balanced and controlled. Therefore, it integrates easily into modern interiors across commercial, residential, and public spaces.

The collection reflects a broader change in how materials are designed and valued. Giano terrazzo tiles offer high durability for interior applications, supporting floors and walls where longevity matters. More importantly, they demonstrate that circular thinking can sit comfortably within contemporary design language.
