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Designed to shape more connected, adaptable and human-centred interiors, Enso is a modular seating and banquette system created for evolving hospitality, workplace and social environments.

Designed and made in the Cotswolds by Lyndon, Enso combines British craftsmanship with a more circular approach to furniture design, balancing longevity, adaptability and material responsibility within one considered system. Soft architectural forms, integrated planting and a refined modular structure allow Enso to create destination spaces that feel both calm and purposeful. From informal collaboration zones and work cafés to hospitality lounges and transitional spaces, the collection brings flexibility, comfort and warmth into contemporary interiors.

Ethan Lee, Production Engineer and Project Lead at Lyndon, says:

“Enso was designed to bring a softer, more natural rhythm into commercial interiors. The idea was to create a modular system that could shape space architecturally, while still feeling calm, welcoming and highly comfortable.

We wanted the collection to feel flexible and intuitive, allowing designers to create everything from quiet retreat spaces to larger social settings through one coherent design language.”

Inspired by the fluidity of organic forms and the philosophy of connected spaces, Enso has been developed as a highly flexible modular platform. Curved and linear elements can be combined to create intimate booths, open social settings, quiet retreat spaces or larger architectural configurations tailored to the needs of each environment. Integrated planter options introduce a softer biophilic layer to interiors, helping spaces feel calmer, more natural and more welcoming.

At the heart of Enso is our long-standing upholstery expertise. Deep cushioning, carefully proportioned backrests and refined upholstery detailing create a level of

comfort more commonly associated with hospitality interiors than traditional contract furniture. Every piece is manufactured with the attention to detail, tailoring and craftsmanship that has defined us for generations.

Enso has been developed with longevity and responsible material selection in mind. The collection uses fully recycled Orbis foam sets from The Vita Group, derived from post-consumer waste streams and designed to support a more circular material lifecycle. Modular construction allows sections to be reconfigured, refreshed or renewed over time, helping extend product life and reduce unnecessary replacement. Integrated power and data options further support long-term adaptability across workplace and hospitality settings.

Enso has been developed as a highly flexible modular system, offering a broad range of curved and linear elements that can be configured to suit everything from intimate hospitality settings to workplace and public environments. Low-back modules create open, collaborative layouts that encourage movement and interaction, while high-back configurations provide greater levels of comfort, enclosure and acoustic privacy for focused work, informal meetings or quieter retreat spaces.

Alongside the standard modular collection, Enso can also be tailored through Lyndon's bespoke manufacturing capability to respond to the exact requirements of a project. Dimensions, configurations and layouts can be adapted to fit architectural features, circulation routes or unique spatial challenges, allowing designers to create seamless integrated seating solutions with the same level of craftsmanship, comfort and design integrity found throughout the collection.
