LUMAE: INSPIRED BY LEGACY, DESIGNED FOR NOW

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Lumae emerged through a close collaborative process rooted in shared values: precision in detail, clarity of form and a belief that innovation should enhance the user experience rather than overpower it. From the outset, the project explored how refinement and strength could coexist, balancing technical performance with a calm, assured aesthetic. Every proportion, surface transition and material decision was carefully considered to create a chair where form, function and finish sit in complete harmony.

The design takes direct inspiration from collections including Paloma, Remi and Amelia, but evolves that familiar language into something more composed and architectural. Lumae carries the softness and warmth that run through the portfolio, yet its broader upholstered planes, flowing arms and monolithic base give it a more grounded, sculptural presence.

Lumae is poised, confident and effortlessly adaptable; a chair shaped not only by aesthetics, but by a shared philosophy of modern British luxury. It is refined yet durable, sculpted yet inviting, and designed to express brand values through materiality, comfort and craft. More than a functional piece, Lumae brings a sense of composure and quiet prestige to the table.

Comfort in Lumae is precisely engineered, with either a loose seat cushion for a softer, more relaxed expression or a fixed seat cushion for a cleaner, more architectural profile. In both versions, the upholstery is tailored with crisp seam lines, balanced proportions and meticulous finishing.

Beneath the surface, Lumae is manufactured using BioPUR® foam, an internal steel frame for structural longevity, and responsibly sourced timber and fixings, all brought together through a design engineered for efficient manufacture. Importantly, the chair is also designed for disassembly, allowing it to be stripped and reupholstered to extend its life and reduce waste.

Lumae's soft radius, flowing inner back and fully upholstered form create an inviting sense of warmth, while the grounded outer silhouette and distinctive under-seat void give it a stronger sculptural identity. The result is a chair that feels unique and statement-making in its own right, yet harmonious alongside the wider portfolio. A familiar softness paired with a more composed, monolithic character that gives Lumae its refined, eclectic style.
