The Installation Process

1. Assessment and Design

3. Edge Installation

Edging stones, bricks, or aluminum strips are installed to define the driveway boundaries and support the resin-bound material.

5. Hand Trowelling

The resin-aggregate mixture is hand-troweled to a smooth, even finish, typically at a depth of 15-18mm.

2. Ground Preparation

A strong sub-base, usually made of compacted MOT type 1 or a permeable alternative, is essential. Existing surfaces may need to be removed, and appropriate groundwork completed to ensure stability.

4. Resin Mixing

High-quality UV-stable resin is mixed thoroughly with decorative aggregates to ensure even coating and optimal bonding.

6. Curing

The surface is left to cure and harden, usually ready for foot traffic within 6-8 hours and vehicles after 24 hours.
