LIQUID METAL RANGE

The application of metal to the doors opens up some of our most beautiful creations, with a range of metals including copper, iron, bronze, and gunmetal. Each metal has its own characteristic that can be further enhanced with our specialist oxidising and patina processes, ensuring that no two doors are the same. However, if a particular door has caught your attention, we can aim to replicate it as closely as possible.

The patina and oxidising process is entirely natural, involving the gradual interaction of metal surfaces with the environment. Over time, exposure to elements such as air, moisture, and various atmospheric compounds causes the metal to develop a unique layer of patina. This process mimics the natural ageing and weathering of metals, ensuring that each door acquires its distinct character and finish without artificial intervention, ensuring no two doors are the same





The patina that develops adds aesthetic appeal and also provides a protective layer that prevents further corrosion of the metal. We then enhance this natural protection by sealing it during our lacquering process, which encapsulates the stunning hues and patterns, giving your door its unique personality.



Taken from quarry surplas, it is more environmentally friendly and has less impact than a natural marble slab. This fusion results in a product that is non-porous, incredibly durable, and resistant to wear and tear.





Accoya and Tricoya have been tested over prolonged periods in all types of weather conditions – above ground, below ground, and even in water – proving to withstand the toughest external environments. Accoya is made from radiata pine that has undergone a mild acid treatment. This process naturally reduces its ability to absorb water, making the timber stronger.

Tested to last 50 years above ground and 25 years in the ground.

Minimal water absorption offers increased stability.



All of our doors are fitted with "Winkhaus" multipoint locking systems as standard, these locks feature a unique day latch facility that works in conjunction with an automatic locking system meaning that you have the option to come and go as you please without locking yourself out.

These locks also have the option to be upgraded to being motorised and operated via fingerprint or keypad entry systems which can be linked to smart home automation systems.


We use two types of hinges on our Inspiration doors the first being a stainless steel shrouded bearing butt hinge. These hinges feature the highest quality sealed ball bearings which ensure your door can open and close effortlessly. These hinges have been time proven and have served us well in the harshest environments for many years.

If an uncluttered look is something you desire we can offer our top of the range concealed adjustable hinges, they feature a three way adjustment with the horizontal, vertical and in out adjustment by a simple turn of an allen key enabling the door to open fully.





Handles: Our standard handle collection features three distinct styles: round ,square, and rectangular, bar handles. These designs are crafted with precision and durability in mind, providing a look that suits a variety of door designs. The round handles offer a classic, smooth grip, while the square bar handles present a more contemporary, angular appearance.
