

Cubbie debuts at Neuroplaces with pioneering OT-led sensory-regulation system

Cubbie is making its debut at Neuroplaces — the UK's first B2B exhibition and conference for neuroinclusive and accessible design — from 15th to 17th September at Protein Studios, Shoreditch where attendees can experience the OT-led sensory-regulation platform in action.

Visitors are encouraged to discover firsthand how Cubbie helps individuals reset and feel ready to re-engage in as little as 10 minutes.

Cubbie's networked sensory regulation system combines a physical sensory hub with a personalised sensory portrait; a profile of each individual's unique sensory needs, and a structured programme developed by occupational therapists (OTs).

Designed to integrate within existing environments, Cubbie uses individual programmes, staff training, usage data, OT expertise, and ongoing optimisation to help organisations deliver the right support, at the right time, at the right level of need.

Independent research shows that 84% of Cubbie sessions result in a positive and regulated outcome. In schools, hundreds of learning hours have been recovered and in one local authority, 16 SEND pupils were successfully reintegrated into full mainstream education.

Cubbie works in any setting before, during, and after dysregulation. It helps teams and staff provide early intervention, targeted support, and specialist provision through one scalable platform:

- **A whole school approach:** to support students and staff with sensory processing differences, ADHD, autism, anxiety, and stress
- **SEND units and specialist provisions:** as a core tool for daily sensory regulation
- **Hospitals, clinics, and therapeutic settings:** to provide consistent, evidence-based sensory support
- **Workplaces:** to provide a safe and quiet environment for employees to self-regulate and return to work
- **Community settings:** to create inclusive and accessible places for neurodivergent individuals so that they can participate and engage in activities

Cubbie will be live on stand DW60 at Neuroplaces. Whether you're a SENCO exploring options for your school, a trust leader looking at consistent SEND provision across multiple sites, or an estates/facilities lead scoping your next sensory space, this is a chance to see Cubbie firsthand, speak with the team, and find out what OT-led sensory regulation looks like in practice.
