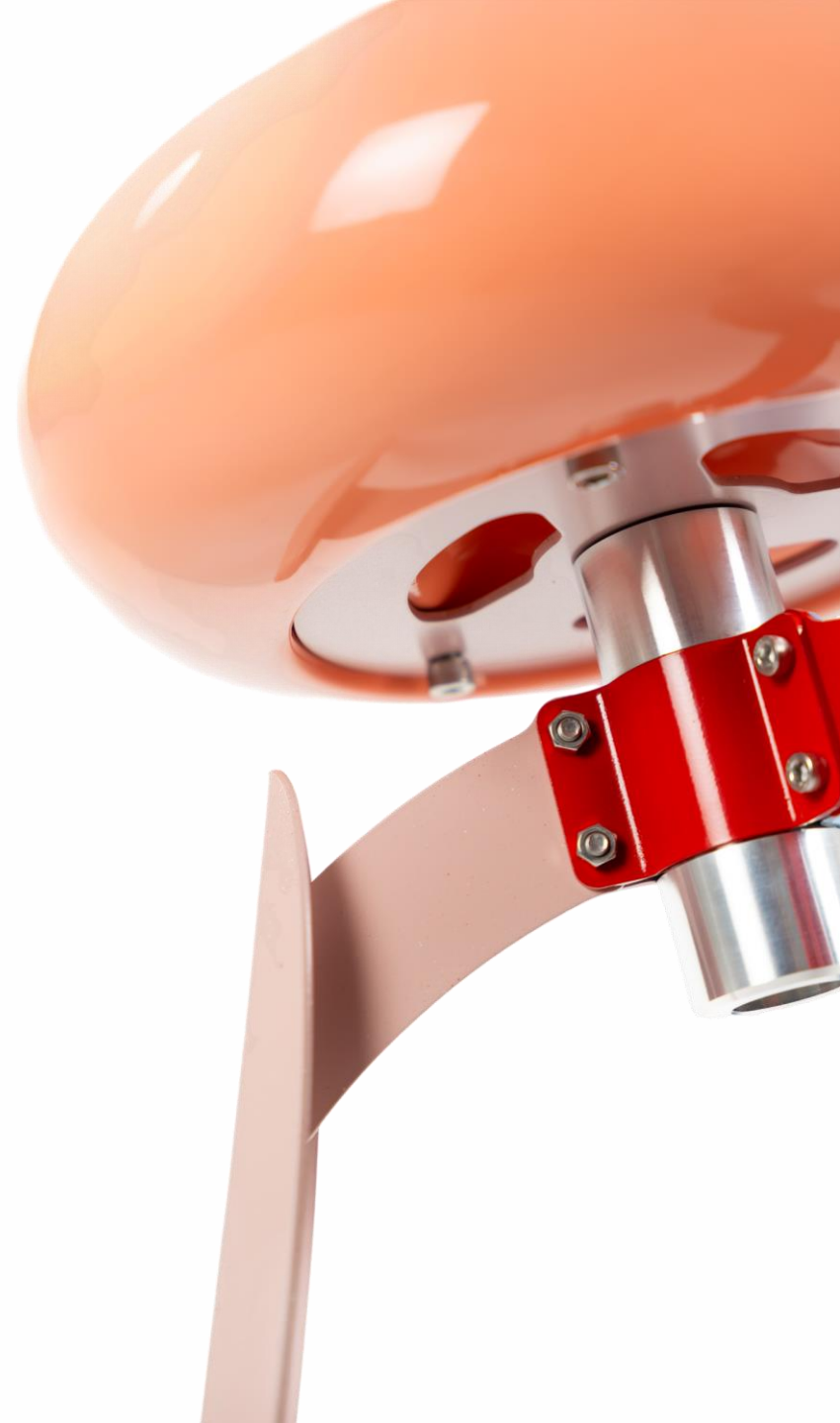

Design Concept

Dot explores the relationship between **structural logic, material and functional simplicity**.

The original stool is built around three curved sheet-steel legs, shaped through a central bend inspired by the form of leaves. The bend creates both the visual character and structural strength of the legs.

A concealed bearing integrated into the central structure allows the seat to rotate freely, adding movement to the otherwise minimal form.



DEVELOPMENT OF THE SYSTEM

Dot was developed as a **design system rather than a single product**. The same structural language has been extended into different furniture typologies, including stools, tables and lamps, as well as collaborative and artistic variations.

The system is based on a consistent structural core combined with interchangeable seat and surface elements. This approach allows each version to develop its own material character while remaining part of the same design family.

PROTOTYPING, FABRICATION & TRANSFORMATION

The first Dot prototype was developed as a fixed welded structure. Through further prototyping and refinement, the connections were redesigned as a fully bolted system, allowing the components to be easily assembled, disassembled and replaced.

This modular construction also enables different seat forms and materials to be introduced without altering the main structural base, making Dot a portable and adaptable furniture system that can evolve over time.



ASSEMBLY & TRANSFORMATION

Each component of Dot is independently designed and manufactured, allowing the system to be assembled, disassembled and reconfigured.

The structure is built around a series of detachable components, enabling different seat forms and materials to be introduced without altering the main structural base.

This approach allows Dot to evolve over time — through changes in material, configuration and use — while maintaining its underlying structural language.
