Why donate?

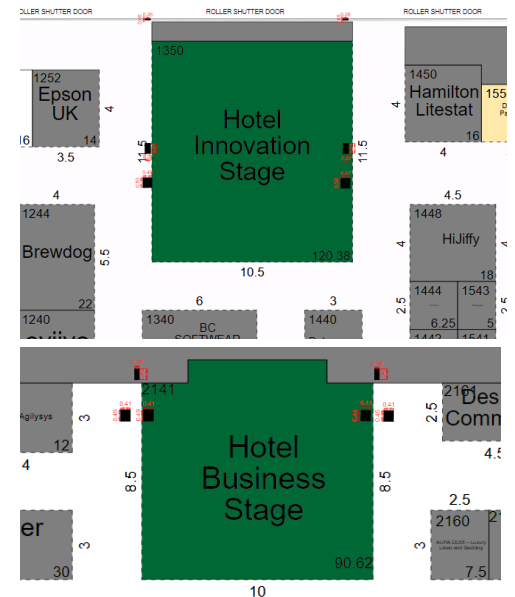
