Competition details (including date and time)	<p>ST9 - Tea Pastries Decoration 30-minute competition – Mon 17th March only</p> <p>Decorate four different pieces of afternoon tea pastries, with one piece of each variety.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Marks will be awarded based on the amount of work completed on-site. • All ingredients are the responsibility of the competitor.
Additional Information for this class	<p>Make sure the base of each pastry is different and you use a selection of different mediums to finish each pastry. Marks will be deducted for running over the 30 minutes allocated so please plan your work schedule correctly. Presentation is to be on 1 plate, slate, tile or board with a written description of each pastry to accompany this. This class will not be tasted.</p>
Arrival Time	<p>Minimum one hour before competition. Please report to Live Theatre registration when you arrive.</p>
Equipment Provided	<p>Workstations comprise a stainless steel preparation table, competitors will be expected to supply all other equipment required for their entry.</p>
Hygiene Products Disposables	<p>Cleaning chemicals such as sanitisers, degreasers and washing up liquid will be provided by Delphis Eco. Cling Film, Foil and Baking Paper will be provided by Prowrap.</p>
Ingredients Provided	<p>Competitors to provide all ingredients.</p>
What are judges looking for?	<p>The judges will be looking for a balance between decoration pieces brought to the competition and the skills shown during the 30 minutes of the event. A pastry may look amazing but if all the decoration was brought finished this will not score as highly as someone who has completed work on site.</p> <p>Please contact andrew.pantelli@montgomerygroup.com should you wish to view a copy of a Skills Theatre judging sheet.</p>
Feedback	<p>Judges will be available at the Skills Theatre for feedback after the judging has been completed, all competitors should make time to do this.</p>
Results	<p>Results will be announced by the Compere and posted on www.internationalsalonculiare.co.uk after the event</p>
Presentation of awards – Time/Location	<p>Located on the presentation stage next to the Skills Theatre. Exact presentation timings tbc - If your class finishes before 1230hrs it will be at approx. 1330hrs on the day of your competition. If your class ends after 1230hrs it will be at approx. 1600hrs on the day of your competition. If you are competing on Weds 19 March, it will be at 1530hrs.</p>
Entry into the show	<p>All competitors will be automatically registered and will receive their entry badge via email however colleagues and supporters <u>must</u> register online www.hrc.co.uk</p>
Arriving at the show and accessing the hall	<p>HRC and Salon Culinaire is in the North Hall at ExCeL London. The closest entrance from the Central Boulevard is N9, the Salon Culinaire is located at the back of the hall and the competitor Registration Desk will be located behind the Live Theatre. (Competitors will be send a map of the Halls with their joining instructions closer to the event.)</p> <p>If you need drop-off facilities, you have two options:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The first option is to drive your vehicle up onto the lorry way and unload your vehicle at the back of the exhibition hall. The venues has implemented lorry way traffic booking system, Voyage Control. To book an unloading slot please click here and create an account on Voyage Control. Booking a delivery slot is quite straight forward, you will need the password 'Salon2025', then select the date and time you will arrive and include your driver and vehicle details. When booking a slot please select 'N18' as your unloading area as this is the closest to Salon Culinaire. When you have finished unloading you must immediately remove your vehicle and proceed to the Orange Car Park, (this is a Pay/number plate recognition car park). If you would like to access the lorry way after your comp you will need to book another slot.

2. An alternative option if you do not require unloading facilities via the lorry way, for easier and quicker access, please park in the Orange Car Park. From there take the stairs or lift to Level 1 which will bring you in to the Central Boulevard and proceed with your exhibit/ equipment to the Salon Registration, as above. All competitors will be given 1 hour free of charge to make deliveries. If you require additional time in the car park, then this will be chargeable per day.
