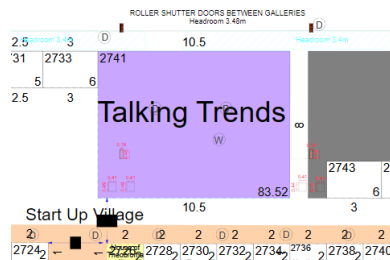
We collect surplus food from **retailers, distribution centres, farms, manufacturers, markets & wholesalers, film shoots and all parts of the hospitality sector**, and deliver it to 350+ charities in every London borough.

Our recipients include homeless shelters, hostels, soup kitchens, mental health charities, community centres and kitchens, schools, family centres, children’s programmes, and domestic abuse refuges.

WHAT CAN YOU DONATE?

City Harvest can collect fresh, frozen, and ambient food. All vans have freezer and chiller capability. All food must have labels with ingredients and **allergens**, be unopened and be within its use by date. City Harvest does not collect hot meals or canteen style food, open food or compromised packaging, food past its use-by date, and alcohol.

The organisers will be setting up 2 collection points for the donations.
