Speciality & Fine Food Fair is proud to partner with City Harvest to collect and distribute food donations from exhibitors

City Harvest rescues food, people, and planet by offering a sustainable solution to surplus for the food and growing industry, diverting quality food from waste and redistributing it to those facing food poverty across London.

The London based operation delivers free food every week to over 375 community partners: foodbanks, schools, hostels, soup kitchens, refuges, and local community hubs. City Harvest currently redistributes 1.2million meals a month, but sadly, has a growing list of more than 20,000 people that are needing help.

WHAT CAN YOU DONATE?

- Everything and anything: food and drink.
- Chilled, frozen, or ambient.
- Products must have a label (in English) with ingredients, allergens, and a use-by or best-before date.
- Products must be in unopened packaging.
- City Harvest cannot accept alcohol.

There will be 2 surplus food collection points at **Drinks Uncovered (940)** on the ground floor or **Talking Trends (2741)** on the gallery level.





When the show shuts on Wednesday 11th September at 5pm, please take your food to one of these collection points. The City Harvest team will be on hand to help.
