
Our recipients include homeless shelters, hostels, soup kitchens, mental health charities, community centres and kitchens, schools, family centres, children's programmes, and domestic abuse refuges.

### WHAT CAN YOU DONATE?

City Harvest can collect fresh, frozen, and ambient food. All vans have freezer and chiller capability. **All food must be unopened and within its use-by date**. City Harvest <u>does not collect</u> hot meals or canteen style food, open food or compromised packaging, food past its use-by date, and alcohol.

The organisers will be setting up 2 collection points at the **Taste the Trends Kitchen** (National Gallery, stand 2725) & **Food for Thought Stage** (National Ground, stand 1450).

When the show closes at **5.00pm on Tuesday 6<sup>th</sup> September** please bring your donations to one of the collection points. The City Harvest and Montgomery Group teams will be on hand on to help.

The 'Guardians of Grub' campaign from WRAP encourages the Hospitality and Food Service industry to come together to rise up against food waste. It takes an enormous amount of time, resources, and energy to produce our food, and then our industry wastes a million tons of it every year. When this waste goes to landfill it produces greenhouse gases, which in turn causes global temperatures to rise.

Our mission is to defend and protect food at all costs and cutback on food waste in our work. Whether it might be spoilage, preparation, or plate waste; we need you to be on the lookout for waste wherever it lurks.

This September, the Guardians are coming together to **Stand Up For Food**, a month-long mission when businesses from across the hospitality and food service sector will be measuring, recording and reporting their wasted food.
