Solution One

Installing a brand-new fence can be both exciting and daunting. So, we took our time to make Horizon Fencing easy to install.

This solution makes use of the following parts:

(A) Corner Post

(F) Fence Panel

(B) Mid Post

(G) Finisher Panel

(C) Wall Post

(H) Post Cap

(D) Gravel Board

(I) Wall Post Cap


(E) Stopper

For a completely wraparound fence, you'll use a combination of corner posts (A) and mid posts (B). If your fence adjoins a wall, you'll need wall posts (C) to complete your fence.

After the posts are secured, fix a stopper (E) at the bottom of each post, then add the gravel board (D) as the foundation for your fencing panels.


Once you've created a level foundation, simply slot in the fencing panels (F), add the finisher panel(G), and secure with a stopper (E) at each end.

Secure post caps (H) on every mid post (B) and wall-post caps (I) on the wall posts (C).




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Full Horizon Fencing System

Solution Two

If you're starting off with existing concrete posts, your new Horizon Fence could be installed in a couple of hours!

You only need these four parts to transform a few concrete posts into a brand-new fence:

- (A) Retro Fit Infill
- (B) Fence Panel
- (C) Finisher Panel
- (D) Stopper

After inserting the Retro Fit Infills (A) into the concrete recesses, you're ready to slide in your fence panels (B)! Add the finisher panel(C) on top and secure with a stopper (D) at each end.



Stoppers are multi-purpose, creating a level base for your fencing boards and securing the fence finishing rail.





CONGRATULATIONS ON YOUR HORIZON FENCE!

We're sure you'd like to get going asap, and our guide will make sure you've got all you need for a proper installation. Here's a handy checklist of *must-dos* and *must-knows* before you jump in.

Preparation List

- Measure and map out your fencing solution before starting installation.
- Store fencing panels flat until use.
- Only install fencing at temperatures above 0 degrees.
- Only use Horizon fittings and screws for best results and to preserve your warranty.
- Don't over-tighten the screws; tighten just until they're flush with the post.
- If two posts are less than 1.8m apart (recess edge to recess edge), you can cut the fencing panels to the correct size without affecting your guarantee or the panel's integrity.

Preparing Your Horizon Fencing Parts Prior to Use

Conditioning


Fence panels and finisher panels have to be conditioned before installation.

- Remove packaging and lay items side by side on a solid, level surface.
- Allow 24 hours conditioning time before trimming to equal lengths.






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Installing Your FenceSolution 1 - Full Horizon Fencing System


Placing Posts

You'll need to secure your posts approximately 24 hours before adding the fence panels, when the concrete is 100% set. (Follow the manufacturer's guidelines for the specific concrete mix you are using.)


Only secure two posts at a time, ensuring your measurements are correct before starting the next section.



01: Mark the two post locations 1871mm apart, centre to centre. This allows the 1.8m fence panels to slot into place when the posts are set.




02: Keeping the marked spot as your centre, dig a 600mm hole, 300mm x 300mm wide.



03: Insert the first post, making sure it's 2.1m above ground level.



04: Following the manufacturer's guidelines, fill the hole with concrete, using supports and a spirit level to ensure it stays level on all sides.



05: Place the second post and repeat, making sure the distance between posts stays 1.8m, recess edge to recess edge.

Installing Your FenceSolution 1 - Full Horizon Fencing System

Wall Post

If your fence starts or ends against a wall, you'll need to fix a wall post to the wall:



01: Before fixing the post to the wall, you'll need to pre-drill 5 pilot holes and counter sinks using a 4mm countersink drill bit.

Place the post on a sturdy worksurface and drill holes at 50mm, 550mm, 1050mm, 1550mm and 2050mm.



02: Level the wall post against the wall, keeping it straight and firmly on the ground.

Using a 5mm masonry drill bit, drill 50mm pilot hole at the top into the wall.



03: Use the supplied screws to fix the post to the wall, taking care to not over-tighten.

Adding Fence Panels



01: Insert the stopper at the top of the wall post, sliding it right to the bottom.



02: Fix the stopper to the wall post with two screws.



03: Repeat on the other post ensuring both stoppers are level.

Installing Your FenceSolution 1 - Full Horizon Fencing System

Adding Fence Panels - Continued



04: Insert the gravel board at the top of both posts and slide it down to the ground.



05: Using a spirit level, make sure the board is 100% level.



06: Slot in the first fencing panel, ensuring it is level before adding the other panels. Each panel should sit firmly on the last, similar to tongue and groove.



07: Add the finisher panel.



08: Slide a stopper onto each post to sit above the finisher panel.



09: Use two screws to fix each stopper into place.



10: Place a half cap onto the wall post and secure with a rubber mallet.



11: Using a 3mm drill bit, drill two pilot holes into the post, using the two predefined holes on the cap as a guide.



12: Fix the cap to the post with the supplied screws.

Adding Fence Panels - Continued



13: Repeat on the other post, starting with a full cap.



14: When finishing your fence, the distance between your second last and last post might be less than 1.8m.

Simply measure the distance between the two posts, recess edge to recess edge, and cut your panels accordingly.




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Installing Your FenceSolution 2 - Horizon & Existing Concrete Posts



01: Thoroughly clean your existing concrete posts with a wire brush.



02: Before inserting the Retro Fit Infill and fixing it to the concrete post, you'll need to pre-drill 4 pilot holes and counter sinks using a 4mm countersink drill bit.

Place the Retro Fit Infill on a sturdy work-surface and drill holes at 50mm, 700mm, 1350mm, and 2050mm.




03: Insert the Retro Fit Infill into the concrete post recess and use a 4mm masonry drill bit to drill 30mm pilot holes. Ensure the Retro Fit Infill is straight before continuing.



04: Starting at the bottom, fix the Retro Fit Infill to the concrete post with the supplied screws. Don't over-tighten.



05: Next, fix the top of the Retro Fit Infill to the concrete post with the supplied screws.



06: Lastly, fix the centres of the Retro Fit Infill with the supplied screws.



07: Once all Retro Fit Infills are secured, slot 5 fencing panels in one by one, making sure each fits firmly on the bottom panel, before stacking on the rest.



08: Add the finisher panel.
